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Classical Divinity

This course of study is open to those who wish to devote themselves to the Christian Ministry or to Missionary work. It differs from the regular Classical Course in that it displaces certain studies with others more distinctively Biblical and practical to the minister. The work represented by this course is as difficult, and we believe as valuable in disciplinary and practical benefits, as that of the other courses. It affords the student an opportunity to shape his College course with special reference to his future life-work.

This course is especially planned for those who wish to make the best possible preparation for their work. It requires a thorough preparatory training for admission. It combines with the regular Classical work such studies as are of greatest worth to the religious teacher.

English Divinity

This course is especially designed for those who wish to enter upon the work of the ministry and can not take the Classical Divinity course. The English course is not to be regarded as equal to the Classical, yet it affords a practical training to those who pursue it. There are already many in the ministry who appreciate their need of Biblical training. This course offers special advantages to such.

This course will be found helpful and practical for ladies who wish to do special religious or missionary work in our cities and towns. The study of the Bible is given a large place. For the same reason it is valuable to Sunday school teachers and superintendents.

Christian Worker's Training Course
