Work On Athletic Field Now at Standstill

Cold Weather Causes Cessation of Activities

Work on the new football and athletic field which is being done by John Phillips, local contractor, has come to a temporary standstill.

The force at work took advantage of the good weather that prevailed for weeks and narrowed the work down to within one day of completion before the recent cold wave forced them to stop.

The work of grading consisted of removing 3000 yards of dirt from the south end of the field to the north. Tile have been laid from the southwest corner of the field thru the length of the field to give sufficient drainage.

What was a year ago an eyesore on the campus will be transformed by next fall into a spot that will add to the appearance of the campus. The tennis courts which are situated just north of the field will be newly equipped.

The erection of a fence around the field has been definitely decided upon but as yet the material of the fence is under consideration. Property holders in the vicinity of the field object to the erection of a board fence and it is probable that a steel fence of adequate size and strength will be finally placed around the field.
