Description:

Three story Federal style brick house with brick console cornice. Slate roof, one remaining chimney in rear wall (interior), at point where ell attached. Typically (Federal) low third story. Four bay facade with door on left, with fanlight. Right side has two bays, left has only one (toward rear). Three story rear ell, clapboarded frame, on second bay from south, with porch and balconies each floor in corner.

An austere, well proportioned Federal house with unusual sidehall plan.

Now surrounded on three sides by Prescott Park.
