Description:

A 2½ story gable-roofed Federal house with gable roof, 3 x 1 bays, 2 chimneys located in rear slope against rear wall, flush eaves. A 1-story modern addition on the left side, and the door has been altered. The house abuts Point of Graves cemetery to the east and faces Prescott Park. Its form is typical of c. 1810-1820 (rear chimneys).
