SHEAFE'S WOODS

Until proven differently, it can be surmised that this tract was part of the farm acquired by Jacob Sheafe from the heirs of Tobias Lear, IV in 1788. Present-day Wentworth road was later cut through part of the farm which laid along the bank of Sagamore Creek.

In August, 1854, a fire raged through the woods, which were described as being "directly south of Sagamore Bridge (q.v.)."

SEAVEY'S WOODS

Along its southern bank Sagamore Creek was the site of several wooded areas. Seavey's Woods was referred to in a Journal item published on Aug. 27, 1870, when a dangerous fire, probably started by a gaggle of boys, broke out. The youngsters had held a picnic there the day before.
