

Description:

A two story Colonial Revival brick building with slightly projecting end pavilions, the latter having blind fanlights above the first story windows. That form is reflected in the semicircular plan of the columnar entry porch and its fanlighted (and sidelighted) doorway. The main windows have shutters and 6/6 sash, and their placement is echoed in concrete plaques set in the parapet above the cornice.

A well composed Colonial Revival building carrying out the predominantly Colonial Revival style of public buildings around the South Millpond.

A 3-story Colonial Revival (specifically Georgian) red brick school building with hip roof, centrally-placed open columnar cupola with bell cup roof. The first story is treated as a classical basement story, supporting the upper two, and has a central doorway with triangular pediments on consoles. At either end of the facade is a 30bay projecting pavilion with hip roof. The main feature of the facade is the central (more shallow) pavilion with a giant Corinthian order of engaged columns - above the first story - supporting a full entablature and triangular pediment. Other details include the window keystones and splayed lintels, the muntin sash (12/12) and the lintel course emphasizing the division between the first and upper stories.

The Portsmouth Junior High School's long classical facade provides a striking backdrop for the South Millpond and corresponds to the 1895 Portsmouth Hospital facade in the same style on the other side of the Millpond. The two provide an interesting commentary on the enduring strength of the Colonial Revival style in Portsmouth.
