Description:

A 2½-story gambrel-roofed brick Colonial Revival building set on a half basement story. The slate roof is broken in front by three shed-roofed dormers of 3, 2, and 3 bays respectively. Likewise, the console cornice surmounts a facade with windows of 3-2-3 spacing, the center two above a portico with console cornice and full entablature set on paired Tuscan columns. Wing to left as noted above.
