



Inclesed fine receipt for check sent and applied to the rent of the Estate of Mrs Ora D Matthews.

In reply to your inquiries will say that, first, that the rent for the first half of yens is due January 1st and if not paid before April 1st a penalty of one per cent per month runs until paid. The second half of the year July is due Satshur 1st and if not paid by October 1st a penalty of one per cent runs until paid. The penalty was charged because you did not pay the second half of 1939 nor the first 1930 rent until August 1st of this year. It is the rule of the Corporation that the tax receipts must be placed in the file of the Treasurer so that they may be in eveidence when the books are audited.

will say that your actual rent for the year on the two lots you have is merely nominal. While it may appear as \$66.70 per year yet you must understand that we receive your tax bills as rent and as they amount to \$62.00. per year your actual rent, or in other words what you really pay us per year in cash, is but \$4.70.




