DEAR LESSEE:-

The Tax Assessor, E. S. Tunstall and Tax Collector, M. H. Wilkins have published that they will be at Fairhope, October 16th, 17th and 26th to receive assessments of taxable property and payment of taxes due. The law states:

"It is the duty of every person liable for taxation to attend in person before the Assessor in the precinct of the taxpayer's residence, and then and there render to the Assessor, under oath, a full and complete list of all property of which he was owner or of which he was trustee or agent on the first day of October of the Year."

When you go to the Assessor be sure to take your last year's assessment with you. Check it over to see if it is in proper order as to the items listed and the valuations. Valuations of taxable property should not be the full value, but 60 per cent thereof, as required by law. If the valuations on the items of taxable personal property returned by you last year, have decreased you should make a corresponding reduction on this year's return. If the improvement value is in excess of 60 per cent of the true value please report the same to me and I will be glad to assist in making a protest.

Should you desire any help in making your assessment this year or if there is any particular information you desire I shall be glad to be of any assistance I can. If you will be unable to attend in person to make your own assessment I will be pleased to act for you provided you supply me with the necessary information and your last assessment sheet.

## Sylvia Logston - Now Ted Wilmer

At the regular Council meeting of the Town of Fairhope, June 13th, 1938, the following resolution was unamimously adopted to facilitate tax collections:

"Whereas the Mayor and Town Clerk, having used every reasonable effort and means to collect taxes,


