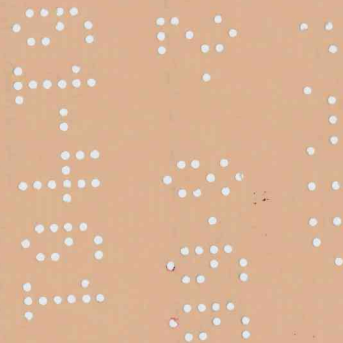

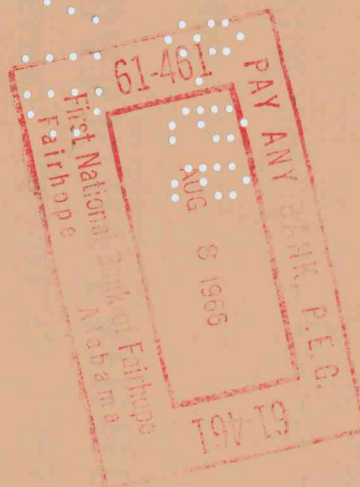

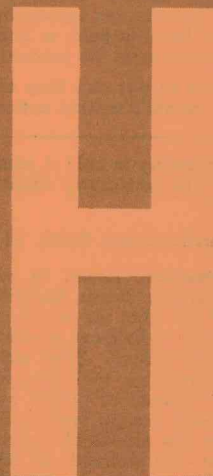

## U.S. SAVINGS BONDS—SERIES H

Bearing Interest Date of June 1, 1959, and After

- Price—Par.
- Dated first day of month in which payment is received by a Federal Reserve bank or branch or the Treasury.
- Mature 10 years from issue date.
- Yield—Pays current income by semiannual interest check to provide an increasing investment yield the longer the bond is held; a bond held to maturity will yield an average of 3¾ percent per annum.
- Redeemable at par any time after 6 months from issue date on 1 month's written notice.

Since the following is only a summary, reference should be made to the governing official circulars for detailed information.\*

**1. Denominations:** \$500, \$1,000, \$5,000, \$10,000.

**2. Registration:** Issued in registered form only; in name of a single owner (individual, corporation, etc.); in names of two (but not more) individuals as coowners; in name of one individual payable on death to one other designated individual. They may also be issued in the names of fiduciaries, including legal guardians or committees and trustees of public and private trust estates; and public and private organizations. They may not be registered in the names of commercial banks, which for this purpose are defined as those accepting demand deposits. They cannot be transferred, sold, or used as collateral or as security for the performance of an obligation.

**3. Who May Own:** Any individual, and any organization except commercial banks. See paragraph 2 above.

**4. Limit on Holdings:** The limit is \$10,000 each calendar year. It applies to bonds originally issued during a calendar year to and held by any investor. For the purpose of computing this limit, bonds issued to coowners may be applied to the holdings of either or apportioned between them.

**5. Where to Buy:** Banks and other financial institutions will accept and forward applications to the nearest Federal Reserve bank or branch for delivery by mail to the registered owner. All applications must be accompanied by payment in full of the issue price. Series H bonds are issued only at Federal Reserve banks and branches or at the Office of the Treasurer of the United States, Washington 25, D.C.

**6. Interest:** Semiannual interest checks will be mailed to holders providing an average annual investment yield equivalent to 3¾ percent per annum when held to maturity. This is better than 2½ percent for the first 1½ years and then 4 percent to maturity. (See table on interest checks.) Yields prior to maturity and at maturity are approximately the same as the improved Series E bonds.

**7. Taxable Status:** Interest is not exempt from Federal income taxes. The bonds are subject to estate inheritance, gift, or other excise taxes, Federal or State, but are

exempt from all taxation imposed on the principal or interest thereof by any State, possession of the United States, or local taxing authority.

**8. Redemption:** At the option of the owner, they may be redeemed AT PAR at any Federal Reserve bank or branch, or at the Office of the Treasurer of the United States, Washington 25, D.C., on the first day of any calendar month after 6 months from issue date, on 1 month's written notice.

**9. Exchange of Series E, F, and J Bonds:** Effective January 1, 1960, Series H bonds may be obtained on exchange for Series E and J bonds, and Series F bonds with issue dates on and after January 1, 1948, provided the Series F bonds are received not later than 6 months from the month of maturity. The owners of the bonds exchanged are granted the privilege of deferring the recognition and reporting of any increment in value (interest) not previously reported for Federal income tax purposes on such bonds to the taxable year in which the Series H bonds received in exchange are disposed of, redeemed, or have reached final maturity, whichever is earlier.

**10. Extension Privilege at Maturity:** None has been provided.
