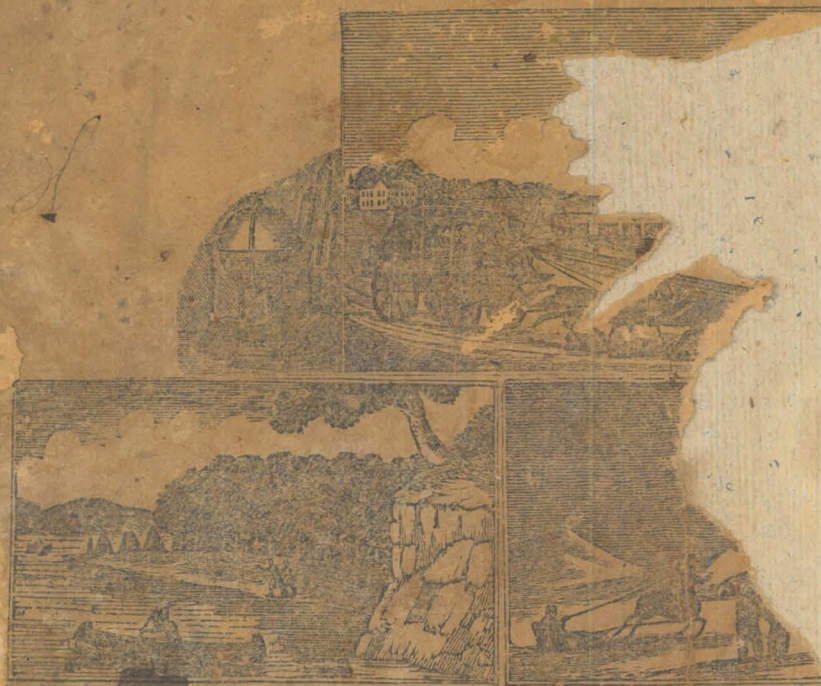

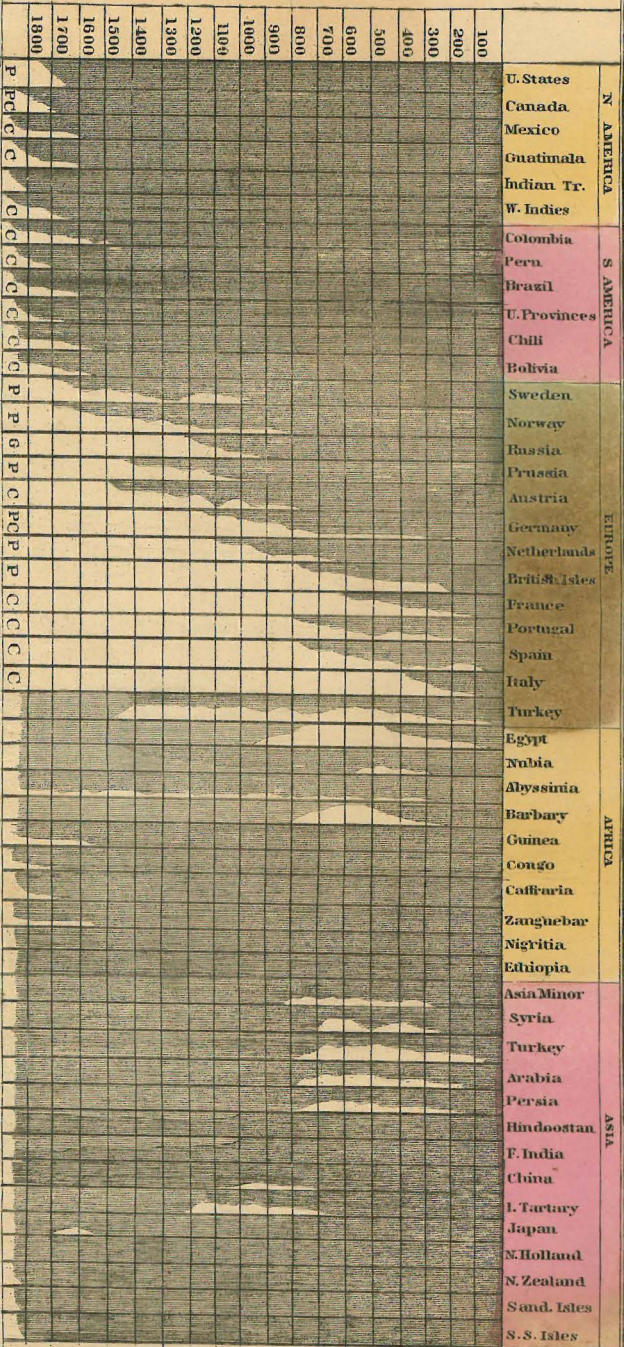

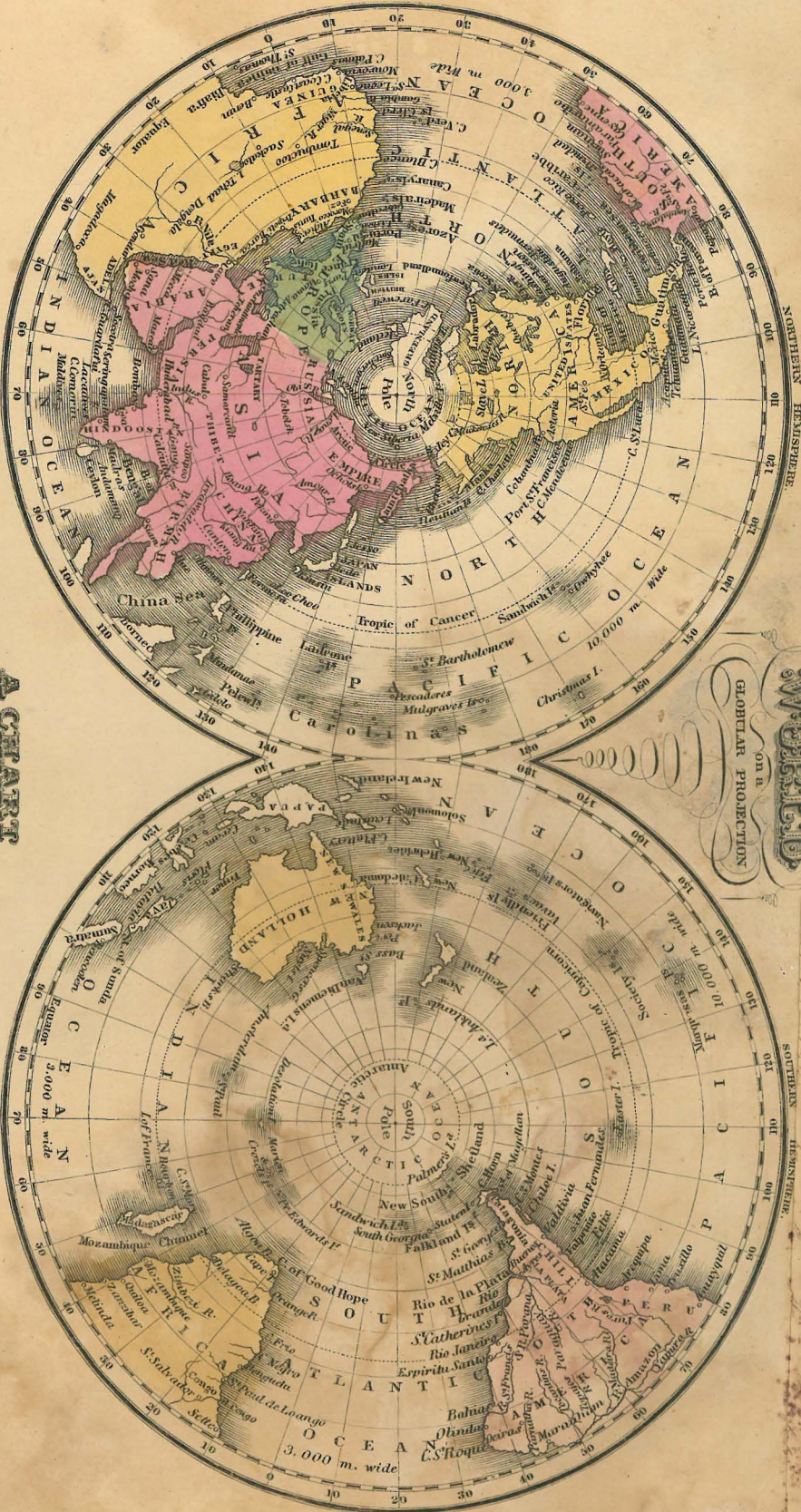
The white spaces show the prevalence of Christianity. The lighter shades that of Mahometanism. The dark shades that of Paganism.

Exhibiting the progress of Christianity from the birth of our Saviour to the present time.

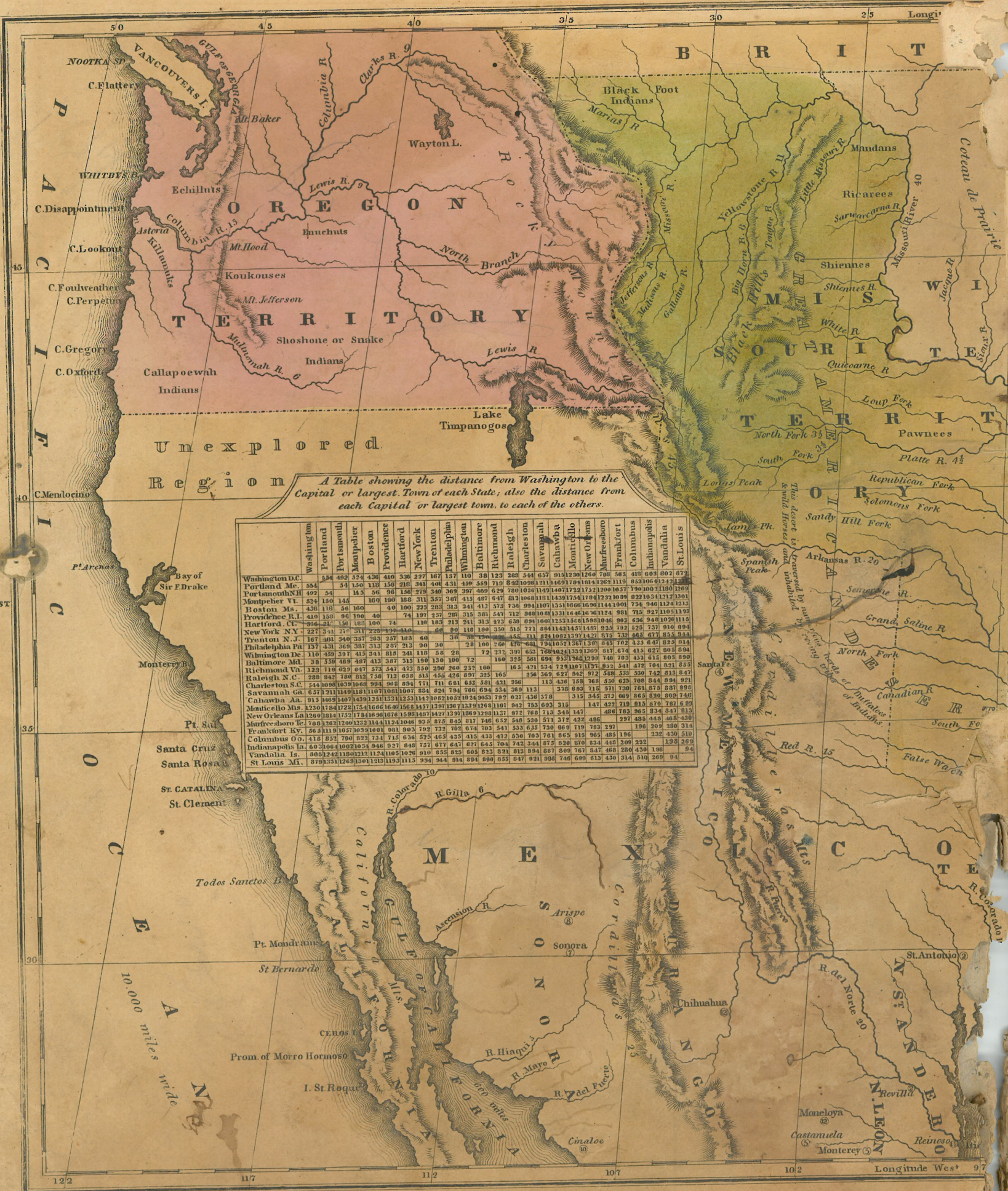

Reformation Dark Ages Primitive Christianity.

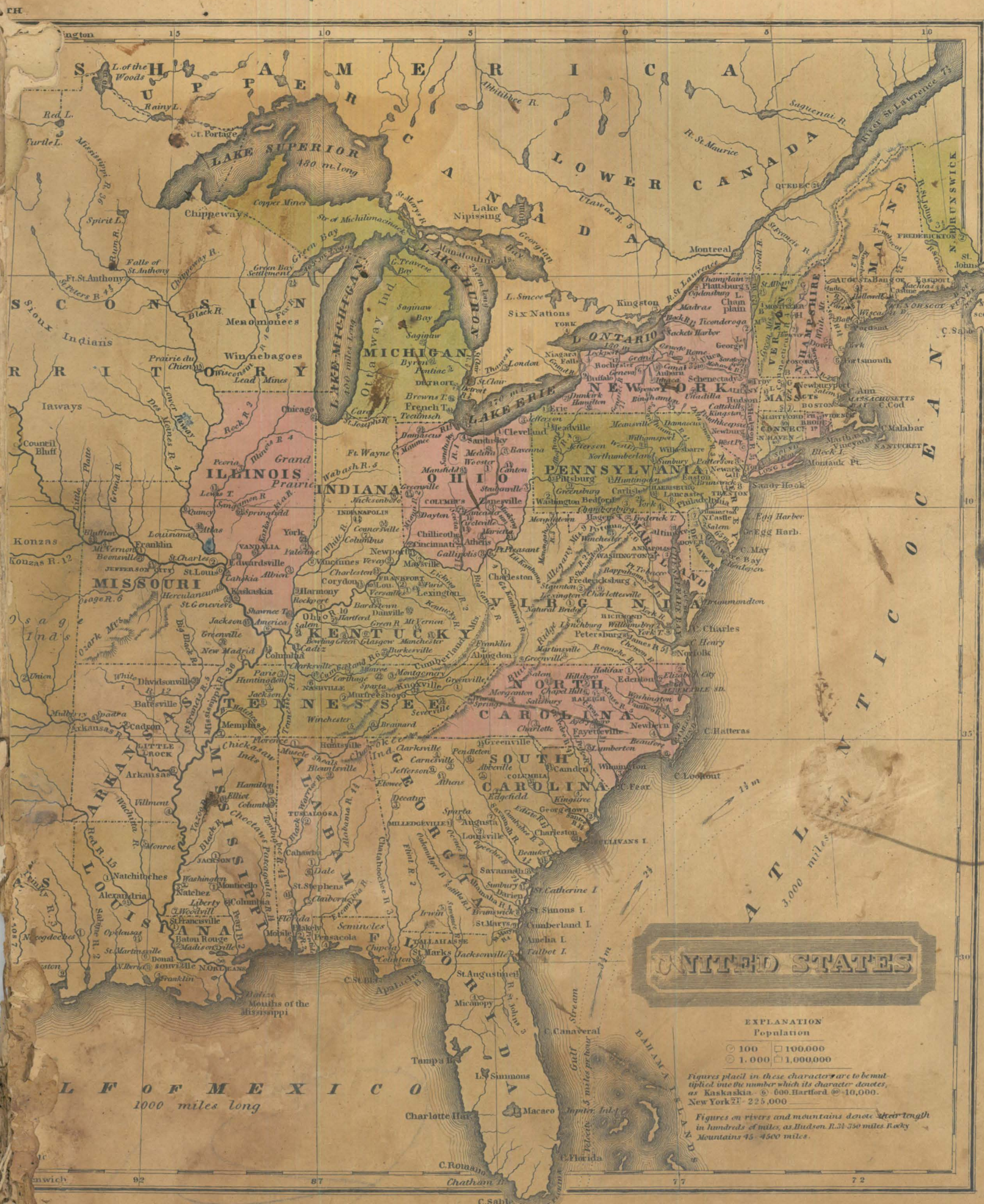

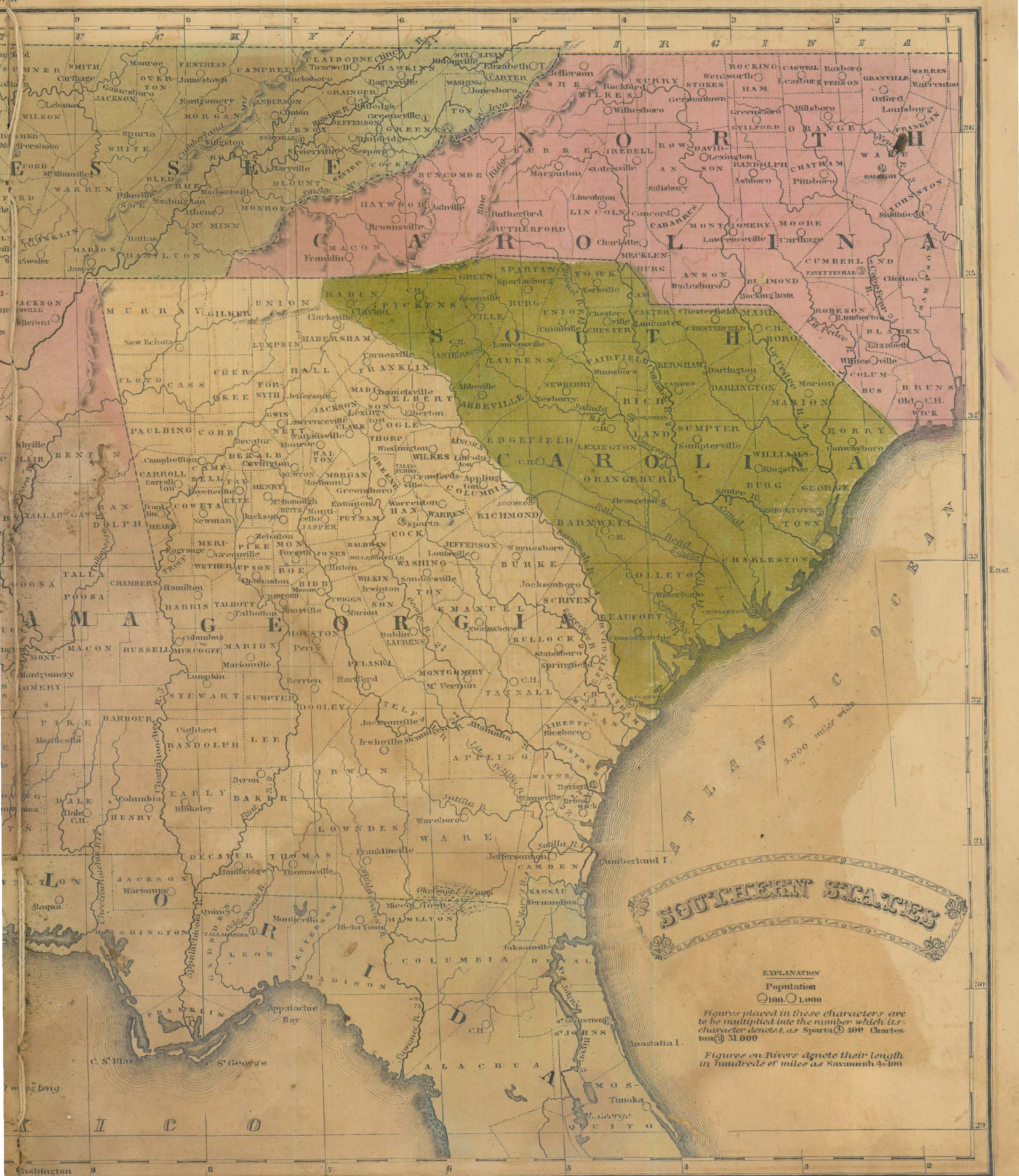

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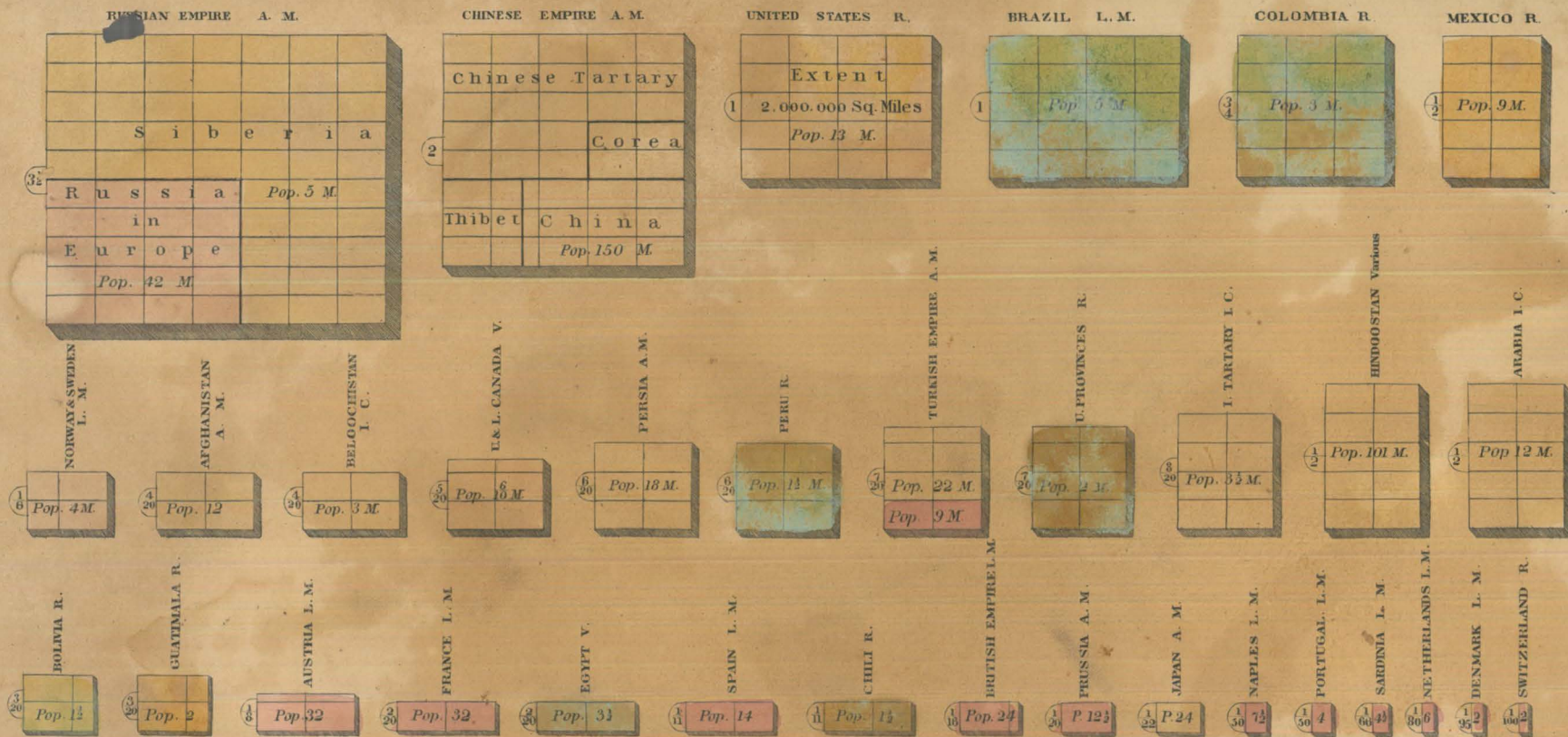
