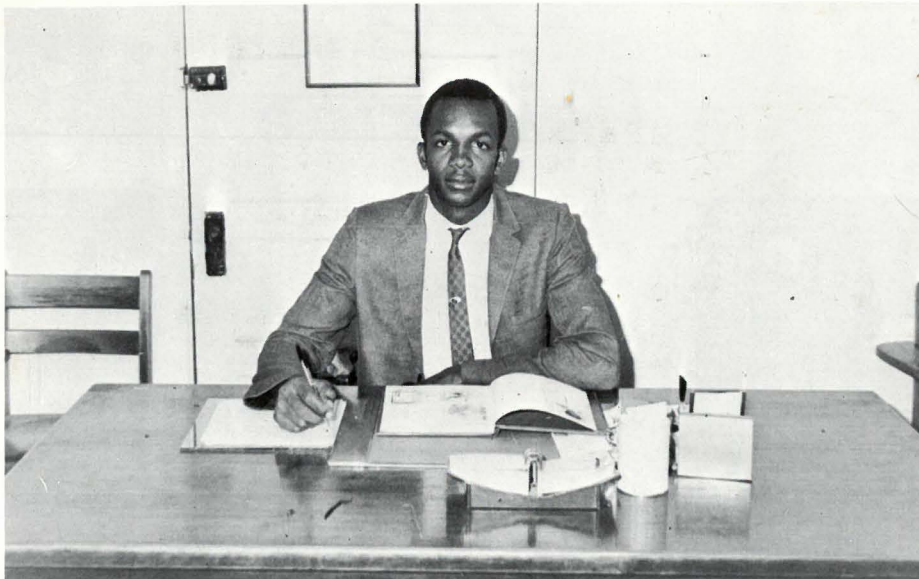

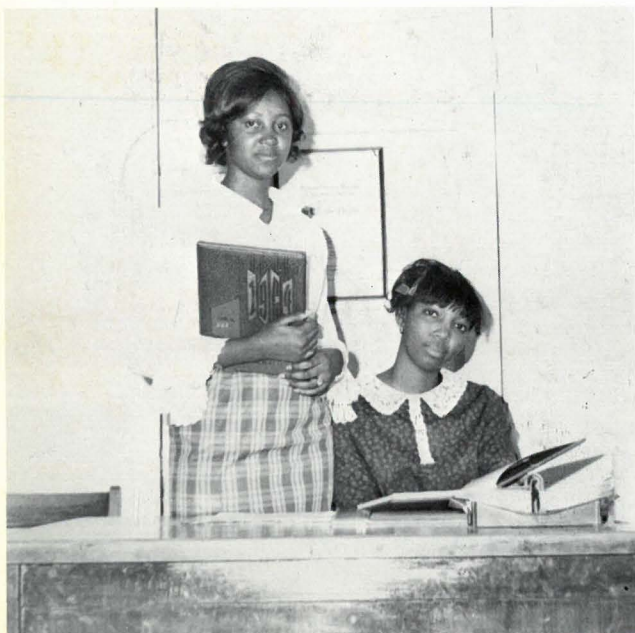
Editor-in-Chief
