

Bridger-Teton National Forest Ranger Roll Call

History – Bridger-Teton National Forest is located in western Wyoming and covers about 3.4 million acres, making it the third largest National Forest in the contiguous U.S. In 1905 President Roosevelt established the Yellowstone National Forest and then in 1908 he abolished the Yellowstone National Forest with its separate divisions and created the Teton, Wyoming (now Bridger), Absaroka and Beartooth (now Custer), Shoshone, Bonneville (now Caribou), and Targhee National Forests. The Wyoming National Forest was renamed the Bridger National Forest in 1941. In 1973 the Bridger and Teton National Forests were combined to form a single forest for administration purposes.

The Forest is currently composed of five Ranger Districts: Kemmerer, Big Piney, Greys River, Pinedale, Jackson, and Blackrock (formerly Buffalo) Districts.
