

Pacific Northwest Research Station

History: The station was officially founded in 1925 as the Pacific Northwest Forest and Range Experiment Station, but Forest Service research in the region began in 1913 at Wind River, Washington.

Organization: The Station is located in Portland, Oregon with 11 laboratories and research centers in Alaska, Oregon, and Washington as well as 12 active experimental forests, ranges, and watersheds.
