The Midland County Circuit Court Records includes all available case records from the Chancery Court, Old Law, New Law and Criminal case series from 1857 through 1946. Records in this collection include divorce records, property disputes, and limited naturalization records.

Reviewing and Requesting Circuit Court Record Case Files

To review the case file visit the MCHS Archives in the H.D. Doan History Center during public research hours, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons from 1pm-4pm or by appointment. Make note of the **Folder title with case # (example: NL#1063)**, **box number** and **folder number** for the record you are seeking.

Submit requests for copies of case files by e-mail to Laudeman@midlandcenter.org, use the subject line: **Midland Circuit Court Records**. Include in the e-mail the Folder Title, box number and folder number. Cost for copies is \$.40 per page, the description of the case will include the number of pages in the file. Please allow 3-5 business days for processing requests.
