Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a **CERTIFICATE** of the Register of the Land Office at Wausau, Wisconsin, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "to secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Kate Devine, widow of Daniel Devine has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the Lot numbered one and two of Section one in Township forty two North of Range five East of the Fourth Principal Meridian in Wisconsin, containing forty four acres and sixty six hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Kate Devine the tract of land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Kate Devine and to her heirs and assigns forever.

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty eighth.
