

19 INDICTED BY U. S. FEDERAL GRAND JURY

Madison, Wis. —Indictments were returned today for 19 persons by a federal grand jury here. Names of those indicted were withheld until warrants had been served.

The following persons already under arrest, were formally indicted:

Edward Fitzgerald, Elroy, Northwestern road brakeman, charged with robbing parcel post packages on his run; Alfred Veetz and William Marcotte, St. Paul, charged with transporting stolen automobiles in Wisconsin, Minnesota and Montana.

Charges against Charles Clemson, Eau Claire, for violation of the Mann act were ordered dropped by the grand jury.
