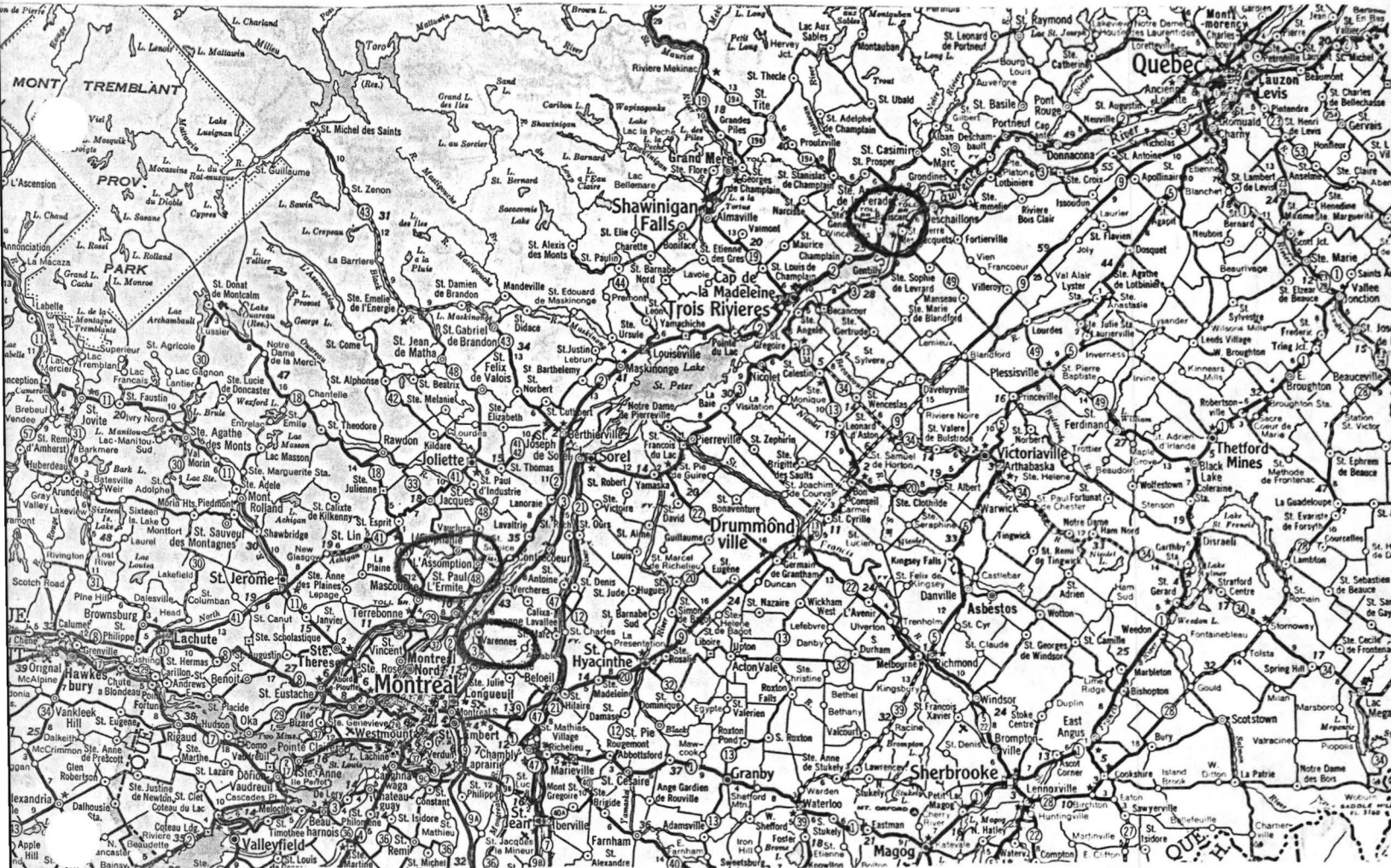

The first Belleque family came to Canada in 1685 from Lyon in lower Brittany(Bretagne) in France. This part of Canada at that time was called "New France". The family name originally was LeBellec. Then it was Bêlec and in the 1880 census in the United States it was spelled Berrick and etc.. The name has been spelled different ways especially in the fur trade days when our men were active in this organization. Most people were uneducated and they went by sound, so thus you will find Billeque, Billeck and so on. The first Bêlec came to Canada in 1685 and "choiced" a farm at Batiscan near Trois Rivières. The map below will show you the places where they lived.

Subjects herein are recorded by generation-For instance Pierre Belleque was born in Canada-Even though we do have geneaology beyond him we will start with him. So he is numbered IC-thus First Generation from Canada. We do not know how many children his parents had but being that they were married in 1780 and he wasn't born until 1797 we will presume that they did have a number of children-So I took the liberty of naming him as an eighth child unless some day we find out differently.

Each generation is separated into chapters. In addition the subjects last number will designate his sequence of birth or #1 for the first born, #2 for the second born etc., the subject's next to the last number will be his father's sequence of birth, as will the third from the last be his grandfather's sequence of birth etc.etc.

Thus IVA-would signify: Fourth American generation, first child of a second child of a third child. The subject's spouse will assume the same number as husband or wife.

Note-I wish to give all credit of the above method that is used in this family tree booklet to my mother's sister and my aunt Mrs, Eleanor Nieland Dowdy.



## FIRST GENERATION HISTORY

IC-8 PIERRE BELLEQUE---Pierre Belleque was born January 9, 1797 in Assumption Canada near Montreal. He was the son of Louison Belec' and Marguerite Baudouin. (Beaudoin)

He joined the Northwest Company in 1820. After the coalition of the Hudson's Bay Company and the Northwest's companies he was employed in the \*New Caledonia district for several years. First as a middle man, then later as a steersman. He left the Hudson's Bay Company in 1832. He had a wife and one child by this time so he decided to settle down.

He took a donation land claim of 320 acres on French Prairie about two miles south of the town of Champoege. With his wife's claim of 320 acres they had a total of 640 acres that they farmed. The place he chose already had a dwelling on it. This dwelling was built around 1812 by Alexander Henry and was called the "Henry House". It was used for storage of furs brought in by the trappers. It also had living quarters in it. This was under the authorization of Dr. John McLoughlin. These fur trappers were really subjects of Canada but begged and pleaded to stay in the Oregon Country where this country was ideal for farming. So in this place he decided to settle. He was one of the first white settlers in this area.

His neighbor was Etienne Lucier. These two men were very active in all affairs that they were confronted with in those days to make a better place to live.

Etienne Lucier, Joseph Gervais and Pierre Belleque were a delegation of three to meet the first priest to come to the Oregon Country. They met him on the banks of the Columbia River, where he arrived by canoe at Vancouver, Washington in 1838.

He chose Genevieve St. Martin as a wife in 1830. His marriage was solemnized at the Catholic Mission on the Willamette by Father Francis Norbert Blanchet on January 21, 1839.

His will was the first one submitted in Marion County. It was written up on the 25th day of January 1848.

Pierre left for the gold fields in May 1849. In October 1849 he contacted an Asiatic Cholera in San Francisco. Then along with about twenty heads of families, some women and children he died on the ship enroute home. He was buried at sea off the mouth of the Columbia River. The reason for this was that there was a storm at sea and they couldn't come over the bar. His fourteen year old son, Pierre had accompanied his father on this expedition but he escaped the dreadful fever and made it home.

The probate of his estate took place March 6, 1850. It was valued at \$3,154.50. He had 50 acres enclosed-45 acres cultivated-he had 700 bushels of wheat. He owned two houses, 9 horses, 28 hogs. In 1844 he owned 20 watches, 400 horses, 1000 cattle-36 hogs. Total value-\$1,468. Poll tax-amount of tax at the rate of 1/8 of 1%=\$2.32. These were the first imposed taxes in Oregon.

He fathered seven children, namely: Sophie, Pierre, Genevieve, Esther, Joseph, Jean Baptiste and Cyprien.

\* New Caledonia was the name given by Simon Fraser in 1805 to the regions of the upper Fraser and Stuart rivers, now roughly corresponding to British Columbia. Later the Hudson's Bay Company made this region a subdivision of its extensive territory with Fort Aleander, on the Fraser River, as the principal trading post.

IG-8 GENEVIEVE ST MARTIN--Genevieve was the wife of Pierre Belleque. e  
She was born in the Oregon Country in 1814. Her parents were Joseph St.Martin and a native woman.(Chinook) She had one sister,Marie-who was married to Thomas Jefferson Hubbard. After Pierre's death Genevieve married Casimir Gardepie. The following children were born to them: Edward-Aug.8,1851-Apr.19,1880; Luce-May 31,1853-Feb.19,1856; Caroline-May 25,1855-1857; Narcisse-Aug.16,1857, Charles Hilaire-1860-1861; Lucien-Apr.27,1862. Casimir and Genevieve were married Nov.25,1850. Sometime after 1862 they moved to eastern Oregon near Athena. Genevieve died in 1904 at the age of ninety years. Note-Narcisse Gardepie married Louise Pauline McKay and had two Children: Esola Clementine Born Jan.5,1884 and William Casimir-Born Nov.15,1887.

JOSEPH ST.MARTIN--Genevieve's father was born in Sorel,Canada-May 9,1784. He was a fur trapper,also.

St.Martin was with David Thompson in 1809-1811 with the Northwest Company. Thompson referred to him several times as "bringing in furs";out looking for horses" and the like,almost always in the company of Jaco Finlay,who was so well known in the Spokane region. One place Thompson wrote:"Martin,insolent;dislocated my right thumb in thrashing him.(May 30,1809,Kootenae House). Joseph would have been twenty four years of age at that time.

Alexander Ross "Fur Hunters of the Far West" wrote: "All being ready,I took Wilson,the gunner and St.Martin,the guide, with us"(They were going out of St.George to capture the renegade Russian, Jacob,who had run away and joined the Indians.) During the darkness of night they rushed the tent they had been informed Jacob was in, and in the melee,"Jacob managed to draw a knife,and making a dash at St.Martin,cut his arm severely." In the end they overpowered Jacob and returned him to the fort,tied up. He mentions both Wilson and St.Martin as"two powerful men"-Probably figured he needed that sort on an errand.

On January 23,1810 word came to the Rainy Lake Post of the Northwest Company that John Jacob Astor was preparing an expedition to the mouth of the Columbia River. Owing to the great necessity, Thompson,despite the hardships of traveling had to reach the Columbia before the Americans and take possession of the region in the name of the British King. He crossed in the middle of the winter arriving in Astoria on July 15,1811 only to see the stars and stripes floating in the breezes of the Oregon Country.

In 1811-the Oregon Country was occupied by the Pacific Fur Company,an American Company. The members of the company were called Astorians. The Astorians traded and trapped here from 1811-1813.

On October 6,1813 a party of about seventy five men(Northwest) arrived at Astoria. The Astoria position being untended. Astoria was sold to the Northwest Company on Oct.16,1813. Joseph St.Martin was with this company. He was listed as #159. St.Martin,Joseph-ducent(capacity) Ft.George(station).

The realization of Thompson's dream had come true. On Monday, December 13,1813 there was lots of merrymaking and celebrating as the British hoisted the English Union Jack and christened Astoria and called it Ft.George.

Then in June 1821-to June 1824 we find St.Martin as employed in the Northern department,this section included George Simpson and John McLoughlin.

A story was told by Marie Clementine Cornoyer Sommerville to Fred Lockley,an Oregon Journal man in 1929that her grandfather Joseph St.Martin and his son were drowned while making a portage on their way to Canada.



## PIERRE'S CHILDREN

IA-8,1 MARY SOPHIE BELLEQUE--eldest child of Pierre Belleque and Genevieve St.Martin was born August 27,1831. She attended school at St.Paul,Oregon. It was taught by the first Sisters that came to Oregon. They were Sister's of Notre Dame that came from Belgium. She also attended school in Oregon City for a time. When she was twenty years of age she was united in marriage to Narcisse Cornoyer. They were married at St.Paul's Mission on the Willamette on September 29th 1851.

She and her husband had eleven children Namely: Marie Ann,Joseph Clovis,Marie Clementine,Edwedge, Melissa, Gustave, Josephine,Cora Genevieve,Edmond Willy and Vital. The last three are not mentioned in the tree as I didn't have this information then. They must have died very young and must have been among those born at the last.

Sophie died May 24,1920 at the age of eighty nine years.

NARCISSE ANTOINE CORNOYER--Husband of Mary Sophie Belleque was born November 11,1820 in St.Clair County Illinois. He played a very important part in the making of Oregon History.

To name some of the few: 1852: Enlisted in first Rogue River War; 1855: Promoted to Major; 1856: Elected Marion County Sheriff; (the first sheriff of Marion County) 1858: Reelected sheriff; Also was on the board to promote the first State Fair which was held at Gladstone,Oregon. In 1864 he moved his family to Eastern Oregon where in 1871 he was appointed Umatilla Indian Agent. He died April 24th,1909 and was buried in Mountain View Cemetery in Walla Walla, Washington. Sophie,his wife is also buried there.

IA-8,2 PIERRE BELLEQUE--Because of his father's name being the same as his he is referred to as Pierre the Second. He was born January 6,1835 on French Prairie. He married Mary Ann Gagnon at St.Louis, Oregon on March 6,1869. They moved to Douglas County where he trapped on the Umpqua River. It is believed he lived near Tiller. Here ,he and his wife became the parents of four children. Namely: William,Gilbert,Mary Clementine and Mary. His wife died in childbirth from the last baby. His wife and child are buried there. Nobody seems to know exactly where. He moved out and brought his three children back up to the Prairie to live with his Sister Genevieve. The baby died three months later. Genevieve and her husband Felix raised the children. Pierre made his home over at Woods,Oregon on the coast and became a fisherman. This is where he died November 13,1913. His remains are at the Catholic cemetery at Tillamook,Oregon.

IA-8,3 GENEVIEVE BELLEQUE--Genevieve was born on the Prairie, April 18,1838. On April 20,1857 she became the bride of Felix Gregoire. They had no children of their own but she raised her brother Pierre's two children. Genevieve's brother Pierre married Mary Ann Gagnon whose mother was Julie Gregoire a sister to Felix. So by marrying Pierre "Uncle Felix" became her brother-in-law. Genevieve-Pierre's sister became his Aunt. Genevieve died January 29,1890. Both she and Felix are buried in the St. Louis Catholic Cemetery.

IA-8,4 ESTHER BELLEQUE--Esther was born Dec.11,1840. On Dec.5,1859 she married Joseph Hibert. They were married ten years and he died. Then she married Moise Tessier. She didn't have any children by either husband. Moise died March 16,1907 and Esther died March 25, 1918. They are both buried in Mt.View Cemetery at Walla Walla,Wash.

IA-8,5 JOSEPH BELLEQUE--Joseph was born in March 1843. When he was baptized his Godfather was Joseph McLoughlin, son of Dr. John McLoughlin.<sup>g</sup> He died May 27, 1848 at the age of five years.

IA-8,6 JEAN BAPTISTE BELLEQUE--John, as he was called was musically inclined. He had been a violin teacher at the Grande Ronde Reserve. John married Victoire Vassal. They had three daughters all whom died very young. His marriage ended in a divorce. His last years were spent with his brother Pierre at Woods, Oregon.

IA-8,7 CYPRIEN BELLEQUE--Cyprien was the youngest child of Pierre Belleque and was just a baby when his father died returning from the gold fields. He married Julianne Bergevin in 1873. They had thirteen children. He was a good fiddler. His wife burned to death in a kitchen fire in 1901. Her small children tried to tear her burning clothing away from her with no success. Cyprien and his wife are buried in St. Paul cemetery.

### THIRD GENERATION HISTORY Pierre's Grandchildren

#### SOPHIE'S CHILDREN

IIA-8,1,1 MARIE CLEMENTINE CORNOYER--Marie was the first child of Sophie and Narcisse. She was born at her Grandfather's house near St. Paul, Oregon. When she was ten years old she attended the Sister's school at St. Paul. Later she attended four years of school at St. Vincent's Academy at Walla Walla, Washington. In 1882 she married Edgar Sommerville. Like her father, her husband was also Indian Agent for the Umatilla Agency. She and her husband had three children namely: Esther, Sydney and Evelyn. She died in 1939 at the age of eighty seven.

IIA-8,1,2 JOSEPH CLOVIS CORNOYER--Joseph was the second child of the Cornoyers. He was born near St. Paul, Oregon also on November 24, 1854. He died at the age of twenty years.

IIA-8,1,3--No name for this number but they were born in 1855.

IIA-8,1,4 EDWEDGE CORNOYER--Edwedge was born in 1856, also at St. Paul. She married Robert Kirk. He was a cousin to the Kirks that were married to her sisters. They had two children.

IIA-8,1,5 MELISSA CORNOYER--Melissa was born near St. Paul too. She married Joseph Forrest and had six children.

IIA-8,1,6 GUSTAVE CORNOYER--Gustave was first married to Lena----- and had two children. Then he married Mamie Rose Bellanger and six more children. Gus was born in 1858 also at St. Paul. The date of his death is unknown.

IIA-8,1,7 JOSEPHINE CLARICE--Josephine was born in St. Louis, Oregon. She was educated in the Catholic schools in Walla Walla. She became proficient in French and music. She married Alexander Kirk, who had come west from Montreal. They were the parents of eleven children. When they were living in Dayton, Washington they had a fire. Books, papers, records and family heirlooms were destroyed but she managed to save one precious item--a quilt made by her great Aunt Marie Hubbard and herself. (Marie Hubbard was Genevieve Belleque's sister). She was born Jan. 23, 1859 and died May 23, 1948.

IIA-8,1,8 CORA GENEVIEVE CORNOYER--Cora was born in 1865 after the family had moved from French Prairie to eastern Oregon. She married Daniel Kirk and they had one child. She died in 1946 at the age of 81 years.

IIA-8,2,2 GILBERT BELLEQUE--Gilbert was born February 1,1871. Probably at Tiller,Oregon near Roseburg where his father was engaged in trapping. His mother died when he was three and one half years of age. So his father brought he and his sisters,Mary Clementine and Mary to his sister's home in St.Louis,Oregon. That is where he lived during his boyhood. At the age of twenty seven years he married Sarah Fayas. Sarah had a little girl whom Gilbert adopted. Her name was Josephine. Shortly after his marriage they moved to Cloverdale, Oregon. They were the parents of seven children-namely: Peter,Ernest,Anna Gustave,Louise, Irene and Charles.

He died November 18,1926 and was buried at Jenck cemetery at Cloverdale. When the cemetery was abandoned the bodies were moved to the old Catholic cemetery at Tillamook,Oregon. It is located within the enclosure of the Blimp Base just south of Tillamook. Other members of the family that were moved at the same time were: Anna Kraemer Belleque(daughter-in-law),Pierre Belleque II,Jean Baptiste Belleque and his son Gus.

IIA-8,2,3 MARY CLEMENTINE BELLEQUE--Clem as she was usually called was born August 17,1872 at the same place as brother Gilbert. Her mother died in childbirth in 1874. So she went to live with her Dad's sister, Aunt Genevieve and Uncle Felix Gregoire. She lived there until her marriage. She was united in marriage to Victor August DeMacon on January 13,1890. They lived at St.Louis where about half of their children were born then they moved to Woodburn. She spent her last remaining years in Canemah,Oregon. She died in her home December 9, 1953 from a heart attack. She is buried in Mt. View cemetery in Oregon City.

IIA-8,2,3 VICTOR AUGUST DEMACON--Victor was born in Rumigny,France on January 4, 1859. When still a small boy the family moved to Librecy only a few miles from his birthplace. This is where he had his First Communion in the village church. He met a girl and fell in love with her but the family wouldn't allow a marriage because she was from a family of means and they couldn't equal it. So he built a shrine in memory of his sweetheart.(Which was still there in 1976 when I was there on a visit. They have a caretaker that maintains it.L.J.B.) He left his little village at the age of twenty three and sailed to America. He came to Oregon where he was employed by the Gregoires. He was very adept at making wooden shoes and made many for the farmers living in that area. He was thirty one years of age when he married Marie Clementine Belleque. He died May 26,1925 while he was working on the job at the paper mill at Oregon City from a heart attack. He is buried in the Woodburn Catholic cemetery in Woodburn,Oregon.

#### CYPRIEN'S CHILDREN

IIA-8,7,2 MARY MALVINA BELLEQUE--Malvina was born about June 4,1874. She married Claude LaCourse in 1890. They were the parents of eight children. They lived many years in Oregon City. She use to visit her cousin,Clementine DeMacon who lived in Canemah,Oregon. They would quilt together and reminisce about the old days. She died in 1950.

IIA-8,7,3 JOSEPHINE CLOTHILDE BELLEQUE--Josephine was the third child of Cyprien and Julienne. She also stayed at the Gregoire's some of the years she was growing up. She and cousin Clem had many good times together. She was born on February 21,1876. On June 27,1892 she became the bride of Louis LaBonte'. They were the parents of seven children including a pair of twins. After her husband's death she was married a second time to John Riner. Josephine died on December 23,1967 at the age of ninety one years.



IIA-8,7,4 AUGUSTINE LOUIS BELLEQUE--August was the first son and third <sup>i</sup> child of Cyprien and Julienne. He was born April 21,1878. On August 16,1904 he was married to Amelia Laderoute. They had a family of two sons and four daughters. He died on November 2,1930.

IIA-8,7,5 FRANCIS BERTRAND BELLEQUE--Frank,as he was known,was the second son and fifth child . He was born April 2,1880 at St.Paul,Oregon. On November 25,1903 he was married to Marguerite Laderoute. They were married in the Catholic Church at St.Louis,Oregon. He was a farmer. They were the parents of six children. In their last years he and his wife lived in Gervais,Oregon. In 1953 they celebrated their fiftieth wedding anniversary with a big celebration. His wife died January 27,1967. He passed away in the Woodburn Care Center on October 28,1973. They are buried in the St.Louis Catholic cemetery.

IIA-8,7,6 MARY LEILA BELLEQUE--Mary Leila was born June 20,1882. She was married first to William Carstens and they had four children: Eva,Robert,Franklin and Ralph. Then with her second marriage she had a daughter,Gladys Mae by George Finch. Her third marriage was to George Baggerly and she didn't have any children by him. She died January 14,1961.

IIA-8,7,9 ROSA JUSTINE BELLEQUE--Rosa was born about January 6,1885. She was married twice,first to George McKay and then to Portwood. She didn't have any children but she helped raise her sister's children,her sister having died at an early age. She died February 23,1965 at Walla Walla,Washington.

IIA-8,7,10 MARIE SOPHIA ODELLA--Marie Sophia was born about March 20,1887. She was married to Frank Thorton on September 13,1903. They had one son Frank Thorton Jr.(He had a family but we have no record of him.) Her second marriage was to August LaChapelle. They had five children namely: Annie,Daisy,Gertrude, Julie and Melvin. Rathy sketchy about her life.

IIA-8,7,11 MADELINE GENEVIEVE BELLEQUE--Madeline was the eleventh child of Cyprien and Julienne. She was born about October 20,1889. She was married to Joseph LaChapelle. She died October 10,1972.

IIA-8,7,12 JOHN ALBERT BELLEQUE--John was born April 13,1892. He was the twelfth child of Cyprien and Julienne. He was married February 12, 1918 in Vancouver,Washington to Frances Hay. He was drafted in the army in the First World War. He was a Private and worked in the Military Police. He was stationed at the Presidio at San Francisco,California. He worked on a variety of jobs: At the Oregon Dental School as a custodian.(He worked for a Dr.Herbert Miller),on a tug boat,for the W.P.A. then back to the dental school until he retired at the age of 61 years. He died November 19,1968 at the age of seventy six years.

IIA-8,7,13 ESTHER LUMINA BELLEQUE--Esther was born October 7,1894. She was married in Washington State in 1912 to Clyde Fuller. They had three children:Dorothy,Sue and Edward. She died May 21,1931 at the age of thirty seven years. It was her children that her sister, Rosa helped raise after her death. She is buried at Walla Walla, Washington. Her husband had died before her on March 17,1924. He is buried at LaGrande,Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,1 MARY HELEN DEMACON--Mary Helen was the first child and first daughter of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August DeMacon. She was born in 1890. She moved to California-possibly at the age of eighteen years. She married George McKay. They had no children. She died at the age of twenty years in 1910 as a result of a ruptured appendix. Her body was shipped by train to Woodburn, Oregon. She lies buried in the Woodburn Catholic cemetery at Woodburn, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,2 GILBERT PETER DEMACON--Gilbert was the first son of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August DeMacon. He was born August 10, 1892 at St. Louis, Oregon. He was a logger and a farmer. He served in the Army in the First World War. He married Addie Watts and they had no children. They lived on a thirty acre farm east of Eugene, Oregon at Lowell. It was situated on the Willamette River. An ideal place for hunting and fishing. The government bought his property and forced him to move in the 1940's. The Meridian Dam waters now cover the property which once belonged to him. He bought an acreage on the hilltop above Dexter, Oregon where he spent the rest of his life. He died February 16, 1976 at the age of eighty three years. He is buried at Mt. View cemetery in Oregon City, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,3 LOUIS JOSEPH DEMACON-- Joe as he was called, was the third child and second son of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August DeMacon. He was born at St. Louis, Oregon on February 15, 1894. He left home at an early age of fifteen years to seek employment in the paper mills at Oregon City, Oregon. He married Hazel Nieland at the age of twenty one years. They reared six children. He was noted for his ability to cure and smoke fish. When work was slack at the paper mills during the depression he worked in logging camps at Westfir, Oregon and Ryderwood, Washington. He also commercial fished at Celilo, Oregon. He made his own fishing nets. Joe and Hazel's eldest child Victor was born at her parent's home west of Canby, Oregon. The rest of the children were born in their residence in Canemah, Oregon. This is where they lived the rest of their married lives. Joe met his death at the paper mill where he fell and fractured his skull. Death came instantly at the age of fifty three years. He is buried at the Mt. View cemetery in Oregon City, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,4 CHARLES CLARENCE DEMACON Charles was the fourth child and third son of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August DeMacon. He was a private in the First World War serving in the Third Oregon Infantry whose headquarters were at Camp Withycombe, Clackamas Oregon. He was in the 162nd Infantry Company F. He was sent overseas to France. (Alsace Lorraine) where he was in active duty-very close to the birthplace of his fathers. He married and adopted his wife's son by a former marriage. They had no children of their own. His occupation was logging. He died suddenly from a heart attack while on the job. He was thirty eight years of age. He is buried at Woodburn Catholic cemetery, Woodburn, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,5 ALFRED OCTAVE DEMACON-- Alfred was the fifth child and fourth son of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August DeMacon. He died at the age of twenty years from the flu which was very prevalent at the end of World War I and took many lives at that time. He is buried at Woodburn Catholic cemetery at Woodburn, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,6 AGNES STELLA DEMACON-- Agnes was the sixth child and second daughter of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August Demacon. Before her marriage to William George Harvey she worked as a seamstress at the Oregon City Woolen Mills. She and Bill were Married August 11, 1920 in Eugene, Oregon at St. Mary's Catholic Church rectory by Reverend Edwin V.O'Hara. They had two children Eldon and Marcene. Her husband died March 1, 1979 as a result of being struck by an automobile at the top of the hill after leaving Canemah towards Oregon City. Agnes and Bill lived their married life in Canemah. A few years later she lived with her son, Eldon. Then she moved to Cape Meares to live with her daughter, Marcene and her husband. This is where she died on April 9, 1986 at the age of 86. She and her husband Bill are both buried in the Mt. View Cemetery in Oregon City, Oregon.

IIIA-8,2,3,7 AMELIA JULIA DEMACON--Amelia was the seventh child and third daughter of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August Demacon. She was born in Woodburn, Oregon. She married Edward Satter in 1920. They had five children. Their eldest child Russell, was killed in World War II in the Saipan engagement in June 1944. They lived in Canby, Gladstone, Oregon City and Salem, Oregon where Ed worked on various newspapers--"The Canby Herald--Oregon City Enterprise and The Salem Statesman. In 1930, for a short time they operated a confectionary store on Seventh street on the hill in Oregon City located on Center Street. A few years before Ed retired he and Amelia operated a grocery store next to their home on Center St. in Salem. Amelia spent the last five years of her life in a wheel chair paralyzed from a stroke. She died in the Mt. Angel nursing home at Mt. Angel, Oregon on June 17, 1968. She is buried at Bellcrest cemetery in Salem, Oregon as is her husband, Ed.

IIIA-8,2,3,8 LOUISE LORENE DEMACON -Louise was born May 4, 1903 at Woodburn, Oregon. She was the eighth child and the fourth daughter of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August Demacon. Before her marriage she worked at the Oregon City Woolen Mills, also as a waitress in a lodge at Lake Tahoe, Nevada. She also attended two years at the Behnke Walker business college in Portland, Oregon. On October 7, 1933 she married George Melum in Carson City, Nevada. Their first home was in the country east of Canby, Oregon. They had two daughters, Marjorie and Barbara. They moved to Toledo, Oregon where George was District Fire Warden for Lincoln County. Louise worked for many years as his secretary. They retired to a farm east of Canby, Oregon where they lived many years. Then they sold the farm and moved to Salem in 1973. George passed away in the Veteran's Hospital in Portland, Oregon on Dec. 10, 1977. Louise died at the age of 87 on September 24th, 1990 at the Mt. Angel Care Center, Mt. Angel, Oregon. She lived the longest of all the ten children that were born to Clementine and Victor Demacon.

IIIA-8,2,3,9 ALEX ERNEST DEMACON- Alex Ernest was the fifth son and ninth child of Mary Clementine Belleque and Victor August Demacon. He also was born at Woodburn, Oregon. He died at the age of eight months from choking on a cookie. He is buried in Woodburn Catholic cemetery at Woodburn, Oregon.

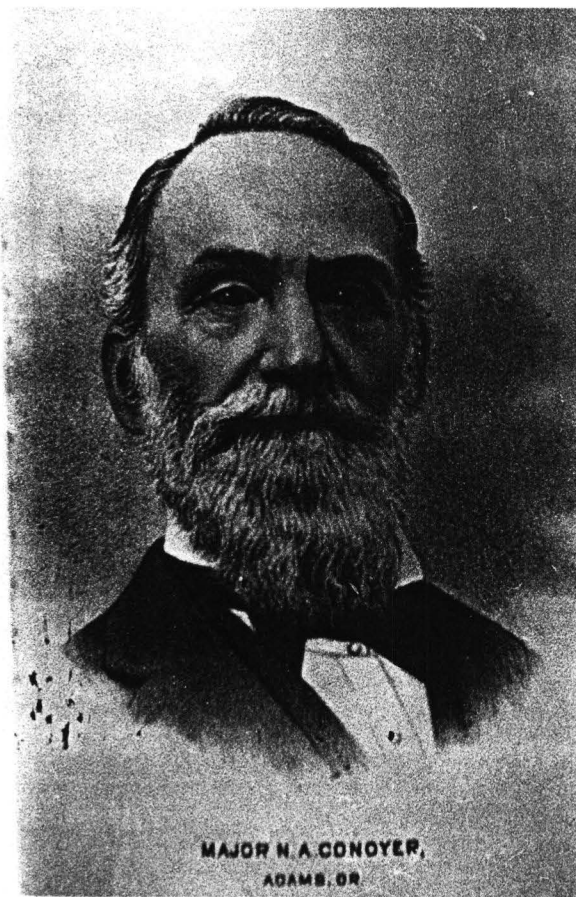

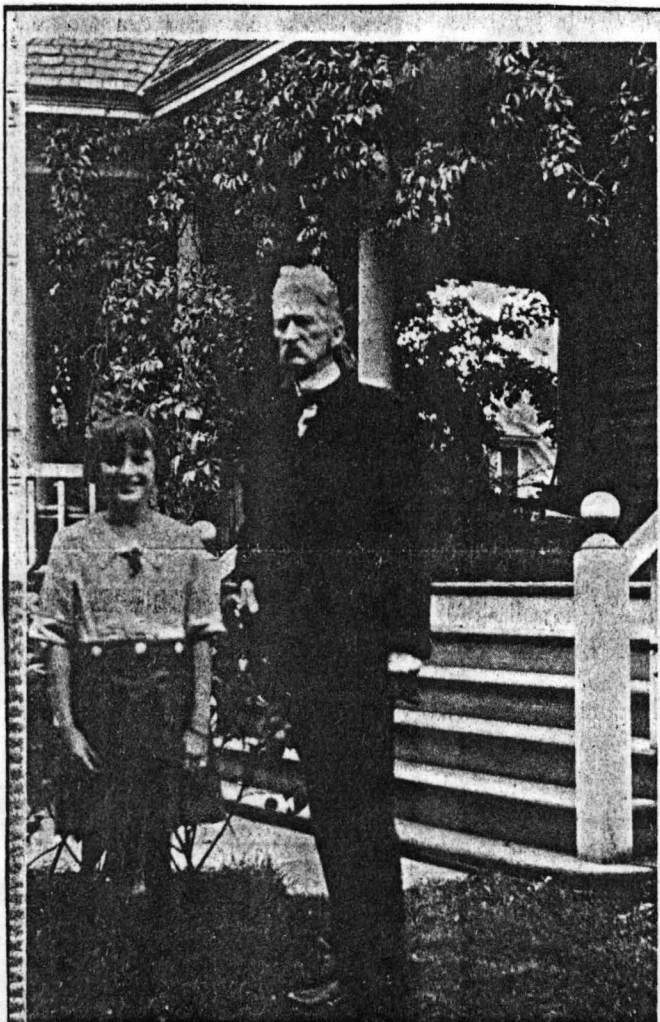

## Sommerville Was Pendleton Druggist

Edgar Sommerville was just five years old when he made the westward trek to Oregon from his Illinois birthplace of Edgar County.

It was 1853 when his father, Alex, left his farm to find a new home in the Oregon country. He finally settled his family near Harrisburg, towards the southern part of the Willamette Valley.

Mr. Sommerville, described by some Pendleton residents who still remember him as a Southern gentleman type, came to Eastern Oregon in 1879. He was a pharmacist by trade although he was involved in a multitude of business dealings.

A partnership was formed with J. H. Raley and the two operated a drug store together in Pendleton. Those who were better acquainted with Mr. Sommerville called him "Doc".

In 1882 he married Clementine Cornoyer, daughter of Marion County sheriff Narcisse A. Cornoyer. They were married in Walla Walla.

Cornoyer later became agent for the Umatilla Indian Reservation, a position that eventually fell into the hands of Mr. Sommerville. Sommerville held the post for about four years.

Although the date is not known, Mr. Sommerville took up a homestead near Cold Springs. The ranch that was built up is still farmed by his grandson, David Lindberg.

Evelyn Lindberg, the only surviving daughter of Sommerville — he had no sons — also lives on the old homestead. The other two sisters were Sydney, a spinster according to a deed transfer, and Esther. Both were older than Mrs. Lindberg.

Mrs. Lindberg's recollection of her father echoes that of others who recalled the man with the long, red and later grey hair.

"He was quite a character," she says.



## *Pendleton landmark*

While in Pendleton recently I visited Mrs. E. J. Sommerville, one of Pendleton's pioneer residents.

"My father, Major N. A. Cornoyer, was born in Illinois, November 11, 1820," said Mrs. Sommerville. "My father was the son of Narcisse Cornoyer, who was born in Canada. His mother, whose maiden name was Mary A. Bernier, was also born in Canada. They were both French. They came to the United States in 1812. In those days the French did not love the English, so my grandfather, Narcisse Cornoyer, enlisted with the Americans and fought the English at New Orleans. He was under command of General Andrew Jackson and they fought behind breastworks of bales of cotton, defeating the English very disastrously. My grandfather also served in the Black Hawk war, in which Abraham Lincoln was the captain of an Illinois company. My father's mother died in 1836, when she was 36 years old. His father died in 1841, at the age of 66.

"My father attended St. Mary's college in Missouri. While still a young man he was appointed deputy sheriff. In 1849, in a company commanded by Colonel Jarrot, he went to California. The next year, 1850, he came up to Oregon, settling on French Prairie, not far from Gervais. Father served in the first Rogue River war in 1852-'53. He enlisted as a private in the Indian war of 1855-'56, but was soon promoted to major. In 1851 my father married my mother, whose maiden name was Mary S. Belique. Mother was born in 1830 and was the eldest of a large family. My mother, her brother Peter and her sister Genevieve went to school to the first Sisters who came to Oregon--the Sisters of Notre Dame. My

Grandfather Belique died at sea while returning from California, when mother was about 17 and was at school in Oregon City. Mary, a sister of my grandmother, Genevieve St. Martin, married Thomas J. Hubbard of Marion county. Joseph St. Martin, my ~~maternal~~ grandfather, and his son were both drowned while making a portage while they were on their way to Canada. His wife, Mrs. St. Martin, afterwards married John Canning.

"Mother's father worked for Dr. John McLoughlin, chief factor of the Hudson's Bay company at Vancouver. In the 30's my mother's father moved to French Prairie. My mother was their first child and I was born on French Prairie at my grandfather's home near St. Paul, on the Willamette river, on September 4, 1852. Father had two farms, one five miles from St. Paul and one at St. Louis, on the Willamette river. Father sold his farm near St. Louis to Ben F. Harding. I attended the Sisters' school at St. Paul with Elizabeth Aplin. The Matthieu girls, Clara and Rosa, were attending school at that time. I was 10 years old when I started to school there. The Sisters taught me, in addition to the regular studies, sewing, French and deportment. Later I attended the St. Vincents academy at Walla Walla. This school was run by the Sisters of Providence. I went there four years and then had to come home so that my sisters could go.

"In 1882 I was married to Edgar J. Sommerville. My husband was born in Edgar county, Illinois, on December 7, 1848. His father, Alez Sommerville, was a farmer. His mother's maiden name

was Elizabeth Stephenson. He had two brothers and two sisters. His sister, Mrs. Jennie Blodgett, who was born in about 1851, lives at Albany, Oregon. My husband crossed the plains to Oregon in 1853 when he was 5 years old. His people settled near Harrisburg, Or. He came to Eastern Oregon in 1879. My father was agent at the Umatilla agency at that time. Mr. Sommerville had a drug store in Pendleton. One day Dr. William G. McKay came out to the agency and Mr. Sommerville was with him. This was the first time we ever met. Colonel J. H. Raley and my husband owned the drug store together. He sold out his interest in the drug store to Mr. Raley and bought a crockery store. He sold this store when he was appointed agent at the Umatilla Agency. We were married at Walla Walla in 1882, by Father Duffy. We lived on the agency during the four years that my husband was agent. We took up a homestead north of Pendleton, on which we proved up and which we still own. We added to this place till we owned 1400 acres there. We built this house here in Pendleton in 1899 and I have lived here ever since.

"My daughter Esther married Arthur P. Sprague. They live in San Diego. Sydney lives with me. Evelyn married Arthur A. Lindberg. He farms our place.

"I was one of 12 children and was the oldest of the family. My brother Joseph died when he was 20. My sister Melissa married Joseph Forest. My sister Josephine married Alex Kirk of Athena. They live at Dayton, Washington now. Edwidge married Robert Kirk.

Impressions and Observations of the Journal Man (cont.)

She and Gustavous are both dead. My sister Cora married E. C. Kirk of Athena. They live in Washington. Edmond, Willy and Vital died when they were young. There are only three of us now living--Cora, Josephine and myself.

"After serving as major in the Indian war of 1855-56 my father returned to French Prairie and was elected sheriff of Marion County. He was reelected and during the time he served as sheriff we lived in Salem. In 1862 he went to the placer mines in Auburn, near the present town of Baker. He mined and ran pack trains until 1864, when he was appointed superintendent of farming on the Umatilla reservation under Major W. H. Barnhart. In 1867 father bought a farm on Birch creek, about six miles from Pilot Rock, where we lived until the fall of 1869, at which time we moved to Walla Walla, where father was employed by Overholtz & Scott, selling supplies by pack train through Montana and Idaho. Next spring we moved to our Dry Creek ranch, near Milton. This was in 1871. We moved there between Christmas and New Year's. We had no snow that year until March, when we got a foot of snow. In 1872 we moved to the Umatilla Indian reservation, as father had been appointed agent of the Umatilla Indians. He resigned in 1875, and in 1876 was reappointed and served four years more."

According to the story told to Fred Lockley, Mrs. Sommerville(daughter of Sophie Belleque-married to Narcisse Cornoyer) said her grandmother, Mrs. St. Martin was remarried to John Canning. I would like to believe that she was married to William Cannon. Maybe she forgot his first name or Mr. Lockley could have written it down wrong. Or maybe the man who copied the story wrote it down wrong. Another reason would be that William Cannon was married to a Chinook woman also that he died in the home of Mr. Belleque. Mrs. St. Martin would be Pierre Belleque's mother in law.

St. Paul records Vol. I,II,III,there is a witness Angelique St. Martin who I cannot place with anyone.This was July 25,1842.Could this be Genevieve and Marie's Mother? Who Knows.

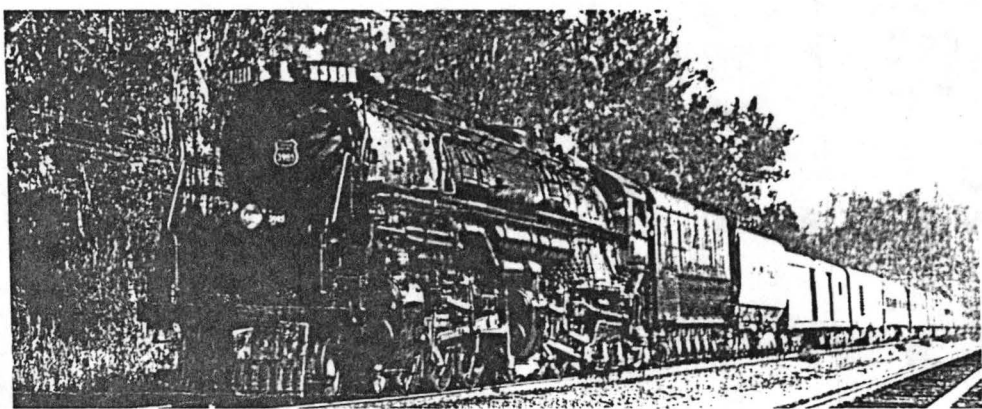

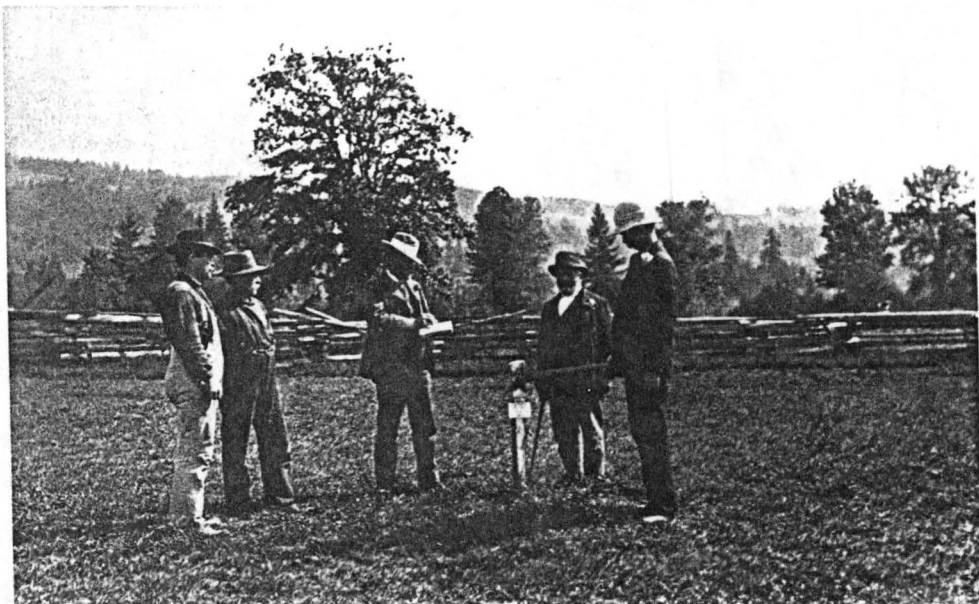
## Oregon Trail Special Offers Chance to Ride the Rails in Celebration of Northwest Heritage

Pacific Limited Group is sponsoring two steam train excursions across the Northwest to mark two milestones: the 150th anniversary of the Oregon Trail and the 50th anniversary of Union Pacific Engine 3985, the world's largest operating steam locomotive. Dubbed the *Oregon Trail Special*, the first trip will run during daylight hours from Salt Lake City to Portland from May 29 to June 3, steaming from the snow-capped Wasatch Mountains through the rugged Blue Mountains to the spectacular Columbia River Gorge. The train will return from Portland between June 12 and 16. One- to six-day trips along the route are available.

Between the westbound and eastbound trips, the *Portland Rose/Deschutes River Special* will steam five hundred miles from Portland, through the Columbia Gorge, to Bend, and back on the weekend of June 5 and 6. Both excursions will be pulled by Union Pacific Engine 3985. The train will stretch for a third of a mile and feature luxuriously restored, full-size, air-conditioned, '50s vintage passenger coaches and dome cars. A museum car and concession car round out the train, which has space for four hundred passengers. Passengers aboard the *Oregon Trail Special* will also enjoy visits to living history programs, including the National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center at Flagstaff Hill, and discover the legacy of railroading in the *Western Star* museum car.

The Pacific Limited Group is sponsoring the steam trains both as a lighthearted adventure travel experience and as a fundraiser. Proceeds generated by the trip will help rescue and restore antique rail equipment throughout America. Thousands of volunteers have banded together to rekindle the romance of vintage trains and introduce a new generation to the power of steam.
