1. The main branches of the family tree are shown on the left side of page one.
2. At the top of the right side of page one is shown Grandpa (Carl) Woodruff's paternal grandparents and their family.
3. In the center of the right-hand side of page one is shown Grandma's mother's paternal grandparents and their family, including Grandma's grandfather, David Burkert (II).
4. On the lower right side of page one is shown the family of Grandma (Ulah Belle) Woodruff's mother's maternal grandparents, including Grandma's grandmother, Abby Dies (Dietz).
5. Page two shows the family of Grandma's grandparents, including her mother, Katharine Burkert. The lower half of the page connects to the top half, showing all of Grandma's aunts and uncles.
6. *Floyd Woodruff was the first in his family to live in Oregon. He was born and raised in Benton Harbor in southwestern Michigan. He married Rosa Kittson, a native Oregonian, in Seattle, Washington, on August 15, 1942. After the end of World War II, they raised their four daughters in Salem, Oregon. Floyd's ancestors lived in Ohio, Michigan and Indiana and were originally from Vermont and New York and Pennsylvania.*




KITTSON FAMILY TREE

1. 1. Pages one and two deal only with the Woodruff Family Tree, and are omitted on some copies.
2. 2. Pages three to six show Grandma (Virginia) Kittson's side of the family, AND HER BROTHER, ALBERT BROUILLARD. ALBERT'S WIFE, MAE (MARY) MCBEAN BROUILLARD, WAS A NIECE OF JOHN MCBEAN (MCBAIN), INTERPRETER ON THE UMATILLA RESERVATION NEAR PENDLETON, OR., IN THE MID-1800'S.
3. 3. The left side of page three shows the Kittson Family Tree with its main branches. The right side shows miscellaneous members of the Rondeau family. There are Rondeaus on both Grandma and Grandpa (Nazaire) Kittson's sides of the family. The exact relationship of the Rondeaus on page three to our Rondeaus is not known, but there seems to be definite links.
4. 4. Pages four and five deal with the marriage line of Grandma Kittson's mother and father, François Brouillard and Aurelie Bonin. The top line on each of these pages shows the direct marriage line. The bottom left-hand side of page four, then, connects to the top half, and page five then connects to four. The bottom right-hand side of page four shows the family of Jacques Servant, whose son, Antoine, married Grandma's "step-sister", Angele Gingras, shown in the top half. Jacques Servant's widow, Josephite or Josette, married Pierre Lacourse (I), whose family is listed on page six.
5. 5. On page five, Grandma's grandparents (Maternal), Pierre Bonin and Louise Rondeau are shown. Her step-grandmother, Rose Wagner, had two sisters named Marie (Anne). The younger one was married to George Chiffman Aplin. The cabin at Champoeg ^{★★} is supposed to have been modeled after the Aplin home. (CHAMPOEG STATE PARK, NEAR ST. PAUL, OR.)
6. 6. ^{*}On page six, no definite relationship can be shown between Pierre Lacourse (I) ^{*} and grandma's great-grandmother, Marguerite Lacourse (shown on page five). However, Pierre's daughter, Marguerite, was married twice and her second husband, Elie Pellan(d), was the widow of Elizabeth Wagner, who was the sister of the above Rose Wagner and the two Marie Anne's.
7. 7. Peter Skene Ogden's family tree is also shown on page six because his wife, Julia, was a half-sister to Joseph Rivet, husband of Pierre Lacourse (I)'s daughter, Rose.

^{*} Per George Brown (in a book by him received in 1993), it has been established that Pierre Lacourse, I., was a half-brother to Marguerite Lacourse Bonin.

^{★★} Champoeg is pronounced SHAMPOO-Y. ~~Many~~ of the original cabins in the area were wiped out by a flood. The D.A.R. built a replica of the Aplin cabin in the park in later years. The Aplin's were step-aunt-and-uncle to Aurelie Bonin Brouillard, mother of Virginia Brouillard Kittson, our grandmother.

Louis Labonté (II)'s marriages are shown on the lower left side of page nine. The Montour's daughter, Isabelle, was the ~~second~~ or third wife of Thomas McKay, McLoughlin's stepson by his second wife, Marguerite (Wadin) McKay. Tom McKay's first wife was a sister of Marie Rondeau's mother (see page three); therefore, Donald McKay and Marie Rondeau were step-first cousins. Donald, Thomas' son, was a friend of Grandma Kittson. He used to drive her to Church in a buckboard. His wife and daughter are shown on the lower left side of page nine because there wasn't room on the other side.




- 16.16. The top half of page ten shows the Pambrun family. Catherine Humpherville Pambrun attended Marcus Whitman's wife, Narcissa, when their daughter was born. Catherine's relationship to the other Humphervilles is not clear.
- 17.17. The lower half of page ten shows the inter-relationships of the McKays and the McLoughlins.
- 18.18. Page eleven shows Charles Lafantaisie's second wife's family. The widow of George Rondeau, Genevieve's brother, married Joseph Chamberland, the son of Adolphe Chamberlain, Isabelle (Humpherville) Lafantaisie's brother-in-law (see page nine).
- 19.19. Many of the old names are spelled various ways. This is because they were spelled according to the way they sounded, sometimes by semi-literate people. Thus there can be both a correct English and French spelling, and mis-spellings of each of these.




They were half-brother and sister, having same father, different mothers.




