Abstract:

The Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, New York Commandery, Records date from 1861 to 1983. The majority of this collection consists of record books, meeting records, membership records, correspondence, financial records, and photograph books. This collection documents the administration and membership of the MOLLUS New York Commandery since its founding in 1866.

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Historical Note

The Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States (MOLLUS)

In response to the assassination of President Abraham Lincoln, The Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States (MOLLUS) was founded on April 15, 1865, in Philadelphia by Lieutenant Colonel Samuel Brown Wylie Mitchell, Lieutenant Colonel Thomas Ellwood Zell and Captain Peter Dirck Keyser. The object of the MOLLUS was and is “to cherish the memories and associations of the war waged in defense of the unity and indivisibility of the Republic; to strengthen the ties of fraternal friendship and sympathy formed from companionship-in-arms; to advance the best interests of the soldiers and sailors of the United States, especially of those associated as members of this Order and to extend all possible relief to their widows and children; to foster the cultivation of Military and Naval Science; to enforce unqualified allegiance to the General Government; to protect the rights and liberties of American citizenship; and to maintain National Honor, Union and Independence.”

Originally, the MOLLUS membership was open to male officers in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps who fought in the “suppression of the Rebellion” (first class Companions), male descendants of officers (second class Companions), or individuals who “...during the Rebellion [were] specially distinguished for conspicuous and consistent loyalty to the National Government, and who have been active and eminent in maintaining the supremacy of the same” (third class Companions). Individuals also had to be recommended by three members, also known as Companions, and to agree and comply with the constitution and by-laws of the MOLLUS.

As of 2017, there are five levels of membership: Hereditary, Junior, Associate, Honorary, and Original. Hereditary Companions are direct male descendants of a commissioned officer of the Army, Navy, or Marine Corps who served during the Civil War, or descendants of a brother or sister of a commissioned officer. Junior Companions follow the same requirements, except they are under the age of 18. Junior Companions cannot vote or hold office within the MOLLUS. Associate Companions are males over the age of 18 who are not eligible for Hereditary membership, but subscribe to the principles of the order, demonstrate interest in the Civil War, and assist in advancing the objects of the MOLLUS. Honorary Companions are elected by either the Commandery-in-Chief or the Commanderies as described in the constitution and by-laws. The fifth category of membership, Original, only applies to veterans of the Civil War.

The MOLLUS is organized into “Commanderies.” The “Commandery-in-Chief” is the main organizational body of the MOLLUS. The first Commandery was the Commandery of the State of Pennsylvania (formed April 15, 1865), which also administered the MOLLUS at the national level until the Commandery-in-Chief formed in 1885.

Throughout its existence, the MOLLUS has been a distinguished society whose membership has included Presidents Rutherford B. Hayes, Ulysses S. Grant, Benjamin Harrison, William McKinley, and President Abraham Lincoln (honorary membership awarded posthumously). The MOLLUS raised support for benefits for military veterans of the Civil War and supported American patriotism and United States military activity. The MOLLUS has also been an active community organizer. For example, the MOLLUS

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purchased tracts of land in Gettysburg and Spotsylvania that were subsequently donated to the National Park Service as part of the battlefield parks.

The MOLLUS, New York Commandery

The New York Commandery became the second State Commandery of the MOLLUS. On January 17, 1866, the acting Commander-in-Chief George Cadwalader issued a charter for the Commandery of the State of New York. The Charter reads:

Ordered: That Lieutenant Colonel Charles G. Halpine, late Assistant Adjutant General, U.S.V.; Brigadier and Brevet Major General Robert Anderson, U.S.A.; Major General John G. Parke, U.S.V., Major Corps of Engineers, U.S.A.; Brigadier General Israel Vodges, U.S.V., Colonel 1st Artillery, U.S.A.; Major General Daniel Butterfield, late U.S.V., Colonel 5th Infantry, U.S.A.; Brigadier and Brevet Major General Samuel W. Crawford, U.S.V., Lieutenant Colonel 2nd Infantry and Brevet Brigadier General, U.S.A.; Brigadier General Guy V. Henry, late U.S.V., Captain 18th Artillery and Brevet Colonel, U.S.A.; Colonel and Brevet Brigadier General Daniel T. Van Buren, Additional Aid-de-Camp, and Assistant Adjutant General, U.S.V.; Brigadier and Brevet Major General Henry E. Davies, late U.S.V.; Lieutenant Colonel and Brevet Brigadier General Martin T. McMahon, late Additional Aid-de-Camp, U.S.V.; Brigadier General Egbert S. Viele, late U.S.V.; Captain William G. Church, late Commissary of Subsistence, U.S.V.; and Captain and Brevet Major Wilson Barstow, Additional Aid-de-Camp, U.S.V.; be and are hereby authorized and [page 2] and empowered to institute and organize a Commandery in New York City, to be known as Commandery No: 1 of the State of New York, of the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States.

And that for the continuance of the organizations of such Commandery, this order should be full authority until the organization of the Commandery-in-Chief of the M.O.L.L.U.S., shall have been effected: When a Charter shall be issued to the Commandery hereby authorized, in accordance with the form prescribed in the Constitution thereof.

Additional Notes and Helpful Terminology

Commandery: The MOLLUS is organized into distinct state groups known as “Commanderies,” referred to as “Commandery of the State of [name of state]” or “[name of state] Commandery.”

Commandery-in-Chief: The “Commandery-in-Chief” is the main organizational body of the MOLLUS, and functions as the overarching national society.

Companion: Members of the MOLLUS are formally known as “Companions.”

The Dames of the Loyal Legion of the United States (DOLLUS): The DOLLUS is the sister organization of the MOLLUS. The DOLLUS was founded in Chicago, Illinois, in 1899 by Ella Thomas Hapeman, the widow of Lt. Colonel Douglas Hapeman. Along with other women, Hapeman founded the DOLLUS for “the wives, mothers, daughters, and widows” of the MOLLUS Companions and their future descendants, with the object “to foster the spirit of patriotism and to cherish the memory of those men and women, whose distinguished service during the Civil War, so largely aided in preserving the integrity of the Government of the United States of America.” The DOLLUS is organized similarly to the MOLLUS and is comprised of State Societies and a National Society.

Insignia number: Individual Companions are assigned an insignia number by the Commandery-in-Chief. Insignia numbers are kept consistently across State Commanderies.

Officers of the MOLLUS: There are several officer roles within the MOLLUS leadership. Officer positions are filled at the state Commandery level as well as the Commandery-in-Chief level. State Commanderies are required to have a Commander, Senior Vice-Commander, Recorder, and Treasurer. The offices of Junior Vice-Commander, Registrar, Chancellor, Chaplain, Surgeon, Judge-Advocate, and Council are optional. The Commandery-in-Chief is comprised of the same Officers; however, “-in-Chief” is added to their titles. For example, the National Commander is known as the Commander-in-Chief.

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Scope and Content Note

Series 01: Meetings and Minutes, 1891-1969

The Meetings and Minutes Series ranges from 1891 to 1969. This series includes minutes from regular meetings, Board of Officers meetings, and special meetings of the MOLLUS New York Commandery. Many folders between the 1930s to the 1960s also include committee reports, circulars, and other paperwork relevant to the meetings. The regular meeting minutes from January 1906 and May 1916 are in very poor condition and are in multiple pieces; use caution when handling these files. The Meetings and Minutes Series overlaps with the General Files Series; researchers should refer to both and use the General Files Series to supplement the Meetings and Minutes Series as there are no minutes in the collection after 1969.

Series 02: General Files, 1957-1983

The General Files Series ranges from 1957 to 1983. It includes a combination of typed and handwritten notes, correspondence, event programs, event information, and everyday paperwork compiled by the Board of Officers, Companions, and New York Commandery staff. The Meetings and Minutes Series overlaps with the General Files Series; researchers should refer to both, especially between 1957 to 1969 because there are only Board of Officer meeting minutes for this time frame.

The "General Files, 1975-1983" folder contains documents about committees, correspondence with the Commandery-in-Chief, membership dues reports, Lincoln Birthday cocktail receptions, and other various material. Whereas the other general files were found together and re-folded, this folder was removed from a miscellaneous box and placed in the General Files Series as it contains similar content.

Documents regarding the Tea Dance were originally in the "January-June 1974" folder. These documents were moved to the Events Series.

Series 03: Financial, 1925-1980

The Financial Series ranges from 1925 to 1980 and contains five sub-series: 03.1: Financial Journals, 03.2: Treasurer's Papers, 03.3: Tax Information, 03.4: Insurance, and 03.5: Miscellaneous Financial. Most of the folders within each of the Sub-Series are ordered chronologically, exceptions are noted.

Sub-Series 03.1: Financial Journals, 1937-1951

The Financial Journals Sub-Series ranges from 1937 to 1951 and contains two oversized, bound volumes. Both journals are a chronological record of the MOLLUS New York Commandery dues, expenses, disbursements, and other financial information.

Sub-Series 03.2: Treasurer's Papers, 1946-1964

The Treasurer's Papers Sub-Series ranges from 1946 to 1964 and contains reports and working papers. The various financial reports are ordered chronologically. The "Treasurer's Working Papers 1958-1964" folder contains statements and notes of the treasurer. The documents in this folder are not in chronological order.

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Sub-Series 03.3: Tax Information, 1942-1971

The Tax Information Sub-Series ranges from 1942 to 1971 and contains various documents including tax exemption materials, federal income tax forms, and New York State tax forms. In the "Tax Exemption Material" folder, the letter to the Bureau of City Tax Exemption includes an attachment which outlines the purpose and goals of the MOLLUS New York Commandery, which is a useful account of the MOLLUS activities from 1957 to 1965.

Sub-Series 03.4: Insurance, 1925-1933, 1955-1962

The Insurance Sub-Series dates from 1925 to 1933 and 1955 to 1962. The Sub-Series contains various filed insurance forms, renewals, updates, and forms regarding the MOLLUS property and the MOLLUS colors (flags).

Sub-Series 03.5: Miscellaneous Financial, 1930-1980, n.d.

The Miscellaneous Financial Sub-Series ranges from 1930 to 1980, and includes several items with no date. It contains various materials, including a deposit book, pocket ledger, stock information, New York State Department of Labor forms, and other miscellaneous financial documents. This series also includes a 1957 financial report by Hugh Grant Rowell which assesses the MOLLUS' financial situation and its financial records and makes recommendations for future financial record-keeping.

Series 04: Membership, 1866-1974, 1980, n.d.

The Membership Series dates from 1866 to 1980, and includes several items with no date. It contains five sub-series: 04.1: Applications and Applicants, 04.2: Declarations, 04.3: Registers and Rosters, 04.4: Committee of Investigation, and 04.5: Miscellaneous Membership.

Sub-Series 04.1: Applications and Applicants, 1866-1974

The Applications and Applicants Sub-Series contains both bound and loose membership applications and membership transfers from other Commanderies, dating from 1866 to 1974. There are four bound sets: 1866 to 1885, 1885 to 1890, 1891 to 1898, and 1899 to 1909. The bound volumes are organized alphabetically; some are indexed. The loose documents were organized alphabetically, and the folder titles were maintained from their original envelope. If possible, related application paperwork is filed with individual applicants' files. Straight pins were removed from the loose applications, but use caution when handling as some may remain.

The "Membership Application Ma-Mi, 1909-1974" folder includes a copy of Douglas MacArthur's application to the Wisconsin Commandery, dated March 8, 1907. A letter, dated January 17, 1963, to the Executive Secretary Miss Ruth Johnston from Recorder-in-Chief J. Truman Swing, is included with the application copy. Handwritten marginalia on the letter reads: "Registered as a member in 'other classes.'"

Sub-Series 04.2: Declarations, 1870-1933

The Declarations Sub-Series contains Declarations of Membership and Declarations of Investiture of Members that date from 1870 to 1933. New Companions signed a Declaration of Membership (DM) which stated that the signer would support the constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations of The MOLLUS. There is one DM per Companion. Declarations of Investiture of Members (DIMs) were signed by Companions elected to office within the MOLLUS New York Commandery and stated that the signer would perform the duties of their position. There can be several DIMs for one Companion depending on how many terms they served in an elected position.

The Declarations Sub-Series contains both bound and loose declarations. The bound items in the Sub-Series include two volumes of DMs and two volumes of DIMs. The loose declarations include both DMs and DIMs from 1903 to 1933. Initially, these documents were tri-folded, and were in neither chronological nor alphabetical order. The documents are now organized alphabetically and each folio is unfolded. There are several groups of DIMs that were in envelopes and organized by year; these were unfolded, alphabetized, and placed in folders that maintained their original chronological arrangement.

Sub-Series 04.3: Registers and Rosters, 1866-1970, 1980, n.d.

The Registers and Rosters Sub-Series ranges from 1866 to 1980 and includes items with no date. Most items in the Sub-Series are oversized, bound volumes. The bound register volumes contain information such as Companion insignia numbers, records of service, election dates, addresses, and membership dues. Some registers have indices. The loose documents in the Sub-Series are typed member lists or memorandums regarding the Companion list.

Sub-Series 04.4: Committee of Investigation, 1866-1925

The Committee of Investigation Sub-Series contains reports that date from 1866 to 1925. The reports were submitted quarterly, following a February, May, October, December pattern; however, there is some deviation. The reports are in chronological order and contain information about the eligibility of individuals for membership based on their lineage.

Sub-Series 04.5: Miscellaneous Membership, 1896-1960

The Miscellaneous Membership Sub-Series ranges from 1896 to 1960. There are several noteworthy items in the Sub-Series, including the membership certificate of William Hemstreet, the only example of a MOLLUS membership certificate in this collection, correspondence between the New York Commandery and the Commandery-in-Chief regarding membership changes, information about membership campaigns, a "Black Book," information about insignia, rosettes, and ribbons, and a scrapbook. The "Black Book" appears to track former Companions from various Commanderies and the reason why their membership ended. Reasons include: "withdrawn," "dropped," "blackballed," "suspended," and "expelled." The scrapbook dates from 1867 to 1904 and contains circulars, correspondence with the War Department and military affairs groups, and communication regarding brevet officer ranks and volunteer officers. The

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scrapbook also contains documents regarding first and second class membership levels, primogeniture, interpretations of the MOLLUS constitution, and membership eligibility. All of the documentation represents the MOLLUS communication regarding membership and the evolution of membership levels as the MOLLUS developed into a larger organization in the decades after its founding. The scrapbook is fragile; the binding is in poor condition.

Series 05: Committees, 1903-1965

The Committees Series ranges from 1903 to 1965. Committees that have their own folders within the series include: Advisory Committee, 1908 Special Committee, Nominating Committee, Soldiers and Sailors Monument Committee, and Civil War Museum and Library Real Estate Committee. The "Miscellaneous Committee Lists and Correspondence 1955, 1961-1963" folder includes documents related to the Admissions, Civil War Centennial, Color Guard, Constitution and By-Laws, Historical Documents, Investments, Increase In Membership, Public Relations, Relief, Nominating, Stewards, Financial, and Membership Committees. The "Committee 1960-1964" folder contains miscellaneous committee rosters, committee lists, and correspondence regarding committee appointments.

Series 06: Published Materials, 1866-1911, c. 1950, 1952-1953, 1960, 1964, 1981, 1985, n.d.

The Published Materials Series dates from 1866 to 1985, and includes several items with no date. It includes four sub-series: 06.1: Circulars, 06.2: Loyal Legion Bulletins, 06.3: Pamphlets, and 06.4: Miscellaneous.

Sub-Series 06.1: Circulars, 1866-1911, 1981, 1985

The Circulars Sub-Series contains circulars from New York, Missouri, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, and the Commandery-in-Chief, which date from 1866 to 1911, 1981, and 1985. Circulars were published by both individual Commanderies and the Commandery-in-Chief. The circulars contain information and announcements, including meeting announcements, meeting summaries, candidates for membership, changes in membership, election information, potential amendments to the MOLLUS by-laws, obituaries, and additional information. Copies of the New York Commandery circulars can often be found in the General Files folders. For the sake of storage space, two circular volumes are in each folder; refer to collection inventory for more details. The bound volumes of this Sub-Series are covered in red rot; use caution when handling.

Sub-Series 06.2: Loyal Legion Bulletin, 1952-1953, 1960, 1964

The Loyal Legion Bulletin Sub-Series includes documents ranging from 1952 to 1953, 1960, and 1964. The sub-series includes copies of the Loyal Legion Bulletin and correspondence between the Commandery-in-Chief and the New York Commandery regarding the Bulletin. The Loyal Legion Bulletin is the quarterly publication for the MOLLUS, published by the Commandery-in-Chief. In 1972, the Memorial Fund of the MOLLUS took over the publication of the Loyal Legion Bulletin and renamed it the Loyal Legion Journal.

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Sub-Series 06.3: Pamphlets, c. 1950, n.d.

The Pamphlets Sub-Series includes two pamphlets, one with an approximate date, and one with no date: "1865 The Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, Commandery of the State of New York" published by the New York Commandery c. 1950 and "What is the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States?" published by the Massachusetts Commandery.

Sub-Series 06.4: Miscellaneous, 1890-1963

The Miscellaneous Sub-Series ranges from 1890 to 1963 and consists of published materials that are cataloged in the Library Catalog but are part of this collection. The sub-series includes books and pamphlets. Rather than listing a box and folder for each item, the call number and bar code are listed. These items are located with the general library collection.

Series 07: Correspondence, 1866-1970

The Correspondence Series ranges from 1866 to 1970. The documents range from higher level Commandery communication with the Commandery-in-Chief, to intra-Commandery communication. The Correspondence Series contains a bound letter book with letters from 1866 to 1876. The series also contains correspondence regarding special incidents or projects, such as the "Correspondence Regarding Commandery-in-Chief Nominating Incident Correspondence, 1943-1944," and the "Civil War Memorial Committee Correspondence, 1960-1970" folders.

Series 08: Events, 1900-1985

The Events Series ranges from 1900 to 1985. This series contains memos, programs, correspondence, invitations related to programs and events held or supported by the membership of the New York Commandery, and schedules of events held throughout the year. Two noteworthy events include the Tea Dance in 1974 and the Lincoln Dinner Dances from 1961 to 1971. Note that some of the Lincoln Dinner Dances were sponsored by the Loyal Legion Foundation, rather than the MOLLUS New York Commandery (see the Loyal Legion Foundation Series).

Series 09: The Loyal Legion Foundation, 1967-1971

The Loyal Legion Foundation Series ranges from 1967 to 1971 and contains four sub-series: 09.1: Trustees, 09.2: President's Files, 09.3: Financial, 09.4: Miscellaneous. The Loyal Legion Foundation (LLF) was founded as an educational institution in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the founding of the MOLLUS New York Commandery. The LLF intended to open a Civil War library and museum in New York City to house the archives and historic material owned by the New York Commandery, to be open to the public for research, to provide educational programming, and to award research grants. In 1926, the MOLLUS New York Commandery donated its library collection, which included books, manuscripts, and other historic material, to The New York Historical Society (see folder "General Files, January-June, 1974"). It is unclear if this collection would have been returned to the Commandery for inclusion in their new library. The LLF disbanded a few years after its founding without achieving these goals.

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Sub-Series 09.1: Trustees, 1967-1971

The Trustees Sub-Series dates from 1967 to 1971 and includes bylaws, information about the charter, correspondence, minutes, and other material related to the LLF Trustees. The minutes include drafts and final copies of trustees meeting minutes, annual meeting minutes, and supporting information.

Sub-Series 09.2: President's Files, 1967-1970

The President's Files Sub-Series dates from 1967 to 1970 and includes working files of Marshall L. Page, who was the first, and appears to be the only, President of the LLF. All files were labeled with only his name.

Sub-Series 09.3: Financial, 1967-1971

The Financial Sub-Series ranges from 1967 to 1971 and includes solicitations, reports, and tax status information.

Sub-Series 09.4: Miscellaneous, 1968-1970

The Miscellaneous Sub-Series, ranges from 1968 to 1970 and includes information about donating copies of the publication *First Century, 1866-1966, and Forward edited, and with a history, by Clark Kinnaird*, to libraries throughout the country. It also includes information about cataloging the LLF collection.

Series 10: Music, 1890, n.d.

The Music Series includes original sheet music and a score for the *March of the Loyal Legion* by John Philip Sousa, and reproductions of the music and lyrics for *Song of the Loyal Legion*, *March of the Loyal Legion*, and *Loyal Legionier*. *March of the Loyal Legion* was composed in 1890 in honor of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the MOLLUS' founding. There are no dates associated with the Music Series, although some dates can be estimated by using publication dates.

Series 11: Photographs, n.d.

There are no dates associated with the Photographs Series. This series contains two sub-series: 11.1: Photo Albums, and 11.2: Photographs.

Sub-Series 11.1: Photo Albums, n.d.

There are no dates associated with the Photo Album Sub-Series. This Sub-Series contains thirty-two photo albums of the New York Commandery Companions, each with fifty photographs. Although there are no dates associated with the albums, the covers are consistent in appearance, suggesting the albums were compiled at or around the same time. Each photo album is stored in an individual box. The spines of the albums are fragile and the album covers are coated with red rot and need to be handled with care. There are two identical indices for the albums; an original in poor condition and a later reproduction; both are inaccurate. The "Series 11, Sub-Series 1, Photo Album Index" that follows the Collection Inventory is a typed index to

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the photo albums. A digital, searchable version of the index is available through the Heritage Center's online catalog.

Sub-Series 11.2: Photographs, n.d.

There are no dates associated with the Photograph Sub-Series. The Sub-Series contains six reproduction photographs each with a corresponding negative. Each reproduction photograph has handwritten information on its reverse, which identifies the subject. The photographs depict some of the charter members of the New York Commandery.

Series 12: Historic Items, 1861-1965

The Historic Items Series ranges from 1861 to 1965 and contains several scrapbooks, a transcript of a Civil War diary of General Alexander Shaler, documents concerning Charles A. Leale, M.D., and a Missouri infantry muster roll. These objects were acquired or collected by the MOLLUS New York Commandery, rather than records related directly to the Commandery. The "Union Envelope Scrapbooks" are a set of seven volumes containing Civil War era envelopes with a variety of themes: pro-Union, in memoriam, patriotic, generals, propaganda, anti-confederate, birds-eye view of cities, camp scenes, and battle scenes. A few volumes contain complete sets of one style of envelopes, one for each state in the Union and sometimes in the Confederacy. Some of these sets have an image of the devil over the Confederate states, including examples in Volume 3. The scrapbook spines read 1861, but the scrapbooks were likely compiled during or after the Civil War.

Series 13: Miscellaneous, 1876-1982, n.d.

The Miscellaneous Series contains items from 1876 to 1982, and several documents and folders with no date. The folders within the Miscellaneous Series are ordered alphabetically. Noteworthy folders within this series include: Board of Relief (likely linked to the Great Depression), Civil War Centennial Commission, Pocket Roster of Pennsylvania Commandery Companions, two clippings scrapbooks, and several newspaper articles and clippings.

The clippings scrapbooks include information about the MOLLUS and its members including obituaries, information about crimes and trials, founding of new Commanderies, the MOLLUS elections and more. Clippings are from various geographical locations beyond New York, including California, Connecticut, Illinois, Mississippi, Ohio, and Pennsylvania. On page 130, there is an article about the MOLLUS' founding and its insignia badge. Both scrapbooks are indexed. Only the first few pages of the second scrapbook are accessible; most pages have water damage and are stuck together. The first clippings are dated 1913, but because of the damage, the last date in the scrapbook is unknown.

The "Honor Roll, n.d." folder contains different versions of published Union and Confederacy honor roll lists. There is considerable overlap between the various lists, but the lists are not identical. It is unclear if the copies that include annotations were preliminary lists with edits, or if the different lists were published over several years and used for different memorial services.

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Arrangement Note

When the collection arrived from the New York Commandery, it was already organized by basic themes such as minutes, financial information, and the Loyal Legion Foundation. This organization was maintained when possible. Folders that did not thematically fit with the surrounding documents were either reassigned to the relevant series, or were placed in the Miscellaneous Series. Whenever possible, the folder titles reflect the previously established titling scheme.

For permanent storage in the collections storage vault, the collection was arranged to conserve as much physical space as possible. All oversized items are labeled "OS" on the box and folder list. For specific arrangement details, refer to the collection inventory.

Two folders were removed from the collection and discarded because of their poor physical condition and because they were not directly related to the MOLLUS New York Commandery. The contained described miscellaneous information regarding the Battle Gettysburg, the burial grounds, tour information, and the town of Gettysburg, Pennsylvania.

Sabol processed the collection between May 2016 and February 2017 while the collection was stored at The Heritage Center of The Union League of Philadelphia, and completed the Finding Aid and Photo Album Index in February 2018 with the assistance of Alex Palma and Keeley Tulio. All were supervised by Theresa Altieri Taplin, Archivist and Collections Manager of The Foundations of The Union League of Philadelphia.

Custodial Note: The records of the MOLLUS New York Commandery were located in the Commandery's office in the Columbia University Club in New York City. At an unknown date, the Commandery's office and records were moved to the St. Anthony's Club (it is unclear if this was the exact name of the club), also in New York City. In 1982, the collection moved to an antiques storage warehouse owned by Colonel David L. Dalva, Past Commander of the New York Commandery, in Long Island City, New York. In 2014, Gerald F. Fisher, Esq., then Commander of the MOLLUS New York Commandery, and Ryan Weddle, a MOLLUS New York Officer, moved the collection to Mr. Fisher's residence in Long Beach, New York. Around the same time, Mr. Fisher and MOLLUS New York Officer Paul Schneider moved records from the home of Past Recorder B. G. Malcolm Smith to Mr. Fisher's residence. In September 2015, Mr. Fisher contacted Theresa Altieri Taplin, Archivist and Collections Manager of The Foundations of The Union League of Philadelphia, to inquire about loaning or donating the collection to The Abraham Lincoln Foundation of The Union League of Philadelphia (ALF). In October 2015, Mrs. Taplin traveled to Mr. Fisher's home to assess and inventory the collection. The ALF expressed interest in receiving the collection as a gift, and in May 2016, the MOLLUS New York Commandery voted to donate the collection to the ALF. On June 20, 2016, Mrs. Taplin transported the collection from Long Beach to Heritage Center of The Union League of Philadelphia, with the exception of some nineteenth and twentieth century minutes retained by Mr. Fisher.
