#### Park Shore Towers Celebrates Topping Off


There was a celebration on the site of Park Shore Towers, located at the north end of Gulfshore Boulevard. The festivities were in recognition of the "topping off" of the West Tower.

Joe Fernandez, Sales Manager of the project, Park Shore Towers, hosted the party to celebrate the milestone in the construction of the elegant and distinctly styled condominium complex. "Right on schedule," said Fernandez. "And we are looking forward to the models being open by January, 1985. With completion of the building some time during the third quarter of '85, we should be ready for another celebration!"

The festivities took place at the unique Sales/Reception Pavilion. Representatives from new projects underway at the Gulfshore Boulevard area were at the party as well as other realtors and key management from subcontractors working on the project.

Trafalgar Developers of Florida, a wholly owned subsidiary of General Electric Company, is the developer of the imaginative project. Their representatives were also in attendance. "This project is an outstanding example of creative design by the developer," said Fernandez. "While Trafalgar has nine major developments in the state of Florida, the company is going the extra mile for Park Shore Towers . . . their first venture in southwest Florida."

With the topping off of the basic structure, work will begin on the



interior and surrounding landscaping and parking area. The unusual parking area is essentially underneath the building, and will not be seen from the building itself.

There will be fountains, streams, walkways and luxurious land-scaping.

The exercise building and clubhouse construction will be moving along as well. The health/fitness complex, also largely hidden by multi-level landscaping, will offer individual men's and women's fa-

cilities that include exercise equipment, saunas/steam baths and locker rooms.

As the photo shows, the building is designed and sited to take advantage of its spectacular location with views of the Gulf of Mexico. Venetian Bay and the Naples city lights at night. There are only four residences per floor and each boasts an oversized private terrace to make the most of the undisturbed vistas from sunrise to sunset.

The Sales Pavilion has the same distinctive features that will identify the "Park Shore Towers" look. The copper mansard roof, the circular Bomanite driveway and boardwalk entrance suspended over a lagoon type pool with bubbling fountains are representative of the elegance that will be Park Shore Towers.

Inside the Pavilion, a warm and welcome atmosphere provides striking graphics and magnificent displays that offer visualization of the ultimate Park Shore Towers ambiance.

The enthusiasm at this celebration was viewed as a forerunner to the exciting year ahead for the Naples Construction and Real Estate sectors in our community. Anticipation of the coming Fall and Winter is in the air . . . The Park Shore Towers celebration was a wonderful way to start the season.

# The Creation Of A Showplace . . . Step By Step.

Since the "topping off", construction work on the interior of The Tower is underway and the latest information is exciting! Trafalgar, committed to creating a showplace in Park Shore Towers, has announced that more selections of floor and wall finishing and cabinets have been made. In the Master Bath, instead of cultured marble as originally contemplated, real Italian marble will be used. The roman tub will be wrapped in this natural marble along with the deck around the tub. The marble is called "Cream of Marfield" and Trafalgar believes it to be the creme de la creme. Vanity tops and shower walls and floors will also be made of this Italian marble now being quarried and cut in Italy to Park Shore Tower's specifications.

In the kitchen, early buyers will have the opportunity to select the

color of the European style kitchen cabinets. The three choices are almond, gray and black, but it may be a difficult decision because all are stunning. The cabinetry is currently on display in the Park Shore Towers Sales Center. Other kitchen upgrading includes full backsplash from counter to cabinet and a full cabinet pantry rather than the bi-fold doors originally chosen for the Tower. You'll find top-ofthe-line General Electric appliances in the kitchen and utility room plus a built-in wet bar with icemaker facing the living room for all your entertaining needs.

Another unique architectural feature will be the tray ceilings in the entry foyer. This ceiling type extends the 7 feet of the wall, then curves up to 8 feet, then flattens at the top. It creates a cove-type dome and is very handsome.

The windows and sliding doors found in the residences are imported from Germany and are being installed by craftsmen sent over from Germany specifically for the Park Shore Towers project. These windows open two ways: like a door into the room or tilt back into the room from the top . . . by use of a simple lever!

Common area upgrading includes the addition of natural Italian marble being cut in Italy, called "Breccia Pernicia" for the plaza lobby levels. And, finally, Park Shore Towers features a majestic four story space frame, serving as a large skylight over the main entrance.

In the words of Joe Fernandez, Project Sales Manager, "Park Shore Towers is Trafalgar's show-case! We are determined to build the finest possible product for the price. The overall quality, especially the interior appointments, is of the highest calibre. Attention to detail is extraordinary . . . nothing has been overlooked."

Carrying through the theme created by the copper mansard roof, copper wrapping around the bay windows and copper panels at the entry to each residence are being

used. This is a unique and costly architectural accent but once again reaffirms Trafalgar's commitment to excellence.

... The Childs Dreyfus Group of Chicago, a leading international design firm, has been awarded the interior design of the Commons Areas throughout the Tower.




