That is exactly what happened two decades ago when a small, but fiercely dedicated group resolved to capture the remaining pieces of Marco Island's 6000+ year history and created the Marco Island Historical Society (MIHS).

Their mission to collect, preserve and interpret history remains even stronger today. It infuses every aspect of our work from our exhibits, to our programs, to our collaborations with multiple organizations. Today, our partners at the Collier County Museums consider the Marco Island Historical Museum the "crown jewel" in their five county museum system. Now, we are getting ready to make history again!

BOLD PLANS


In late 2014, the MIHS launched a CATapult Campaign which is designed to raise \$1.185 million over a three year period to fund the four main goals of our recently completed Strategic Plan. The number one goal is to bring back a number of the famous Key Marco artifacts on loan for a series of special exhibits. Excavated from Marco Island in 1896, these artifacts are being preserved by some of the world's most respected museums, including the Smithsonian, the Florida Museum of Natural History, the University of Pennsylvania,

and the British Museum. Before any of these institutions will consent to send such valuable artifacts to the Marco Island Historical Museum, we have extensive preparatory work to complete. Raising the funds now assures that we are ready to exhibit and care for these fragile treasures. Initial discussions with the Smithsonian last December were very positive and they have agreed to work with the MIHS and our partners at the Collier County Museums on a loan agreement to display the Key Marco Cat and related artifacts.

Making History (Again!)

To raise the bulk of the funds, the MIHS has created a special project that focuses on what we do best - history! The Windows & Doors to History represent the final phase of completing the Marco Museum – inside and out. As the permanent exhibits are being constructed inside the Museum,

the 19 Windows and three doors will also come to life, vividly portraying Marco Island's history from the Ice Age to Modern Marco in an "outdoor exhibit". Working with artists (one artist for each historic period), the Windows on each side of the Museum complex will - just like the exhibits inside the Museum - tell the story of Marco Island's unique history.
