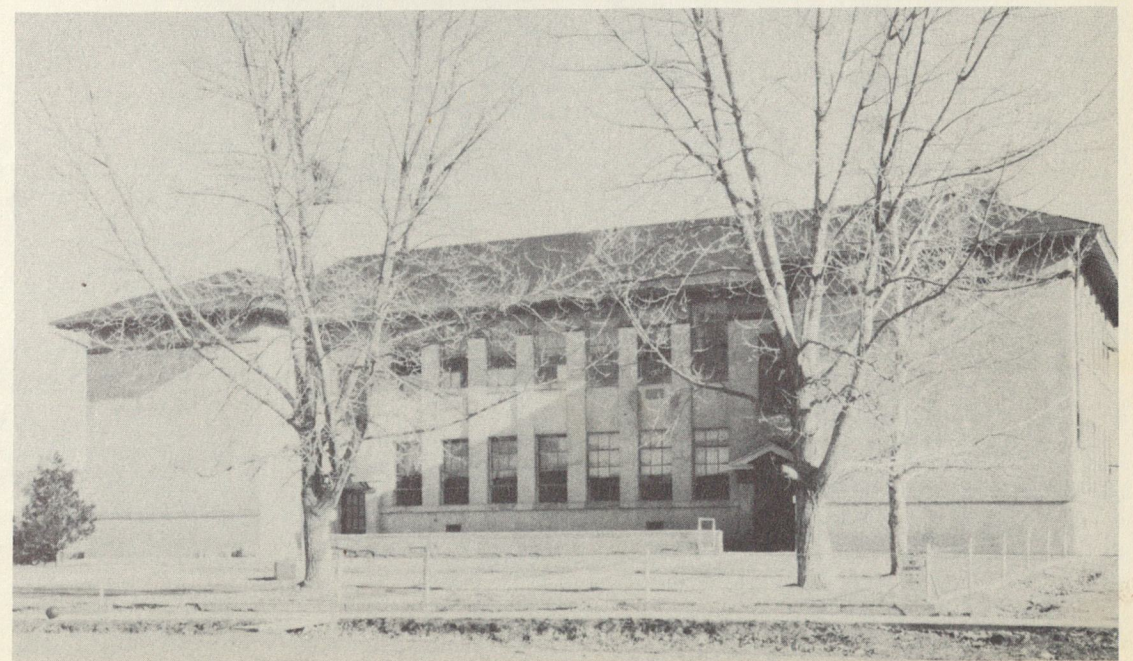
We dedicate this 1952 Spur to our posterity
