
## **Foreword**

which was a great success.





During the year we raised enough additional funds to help pay for part of the fare for all of our class to go to Denver, April 13 & 14, on the Burlington Railroad Education Tour.




The Longhorn Staff published six issues this year, one every six weeks. The paper was attractively made with different colored ink and paper.


Uncle Bob-- About forty or so. Although he's a mortician, he's jovial, loves his family and loves a good joke as well as anyone.-Lon Hovey.


Jess wins the 100 yd. dash.






