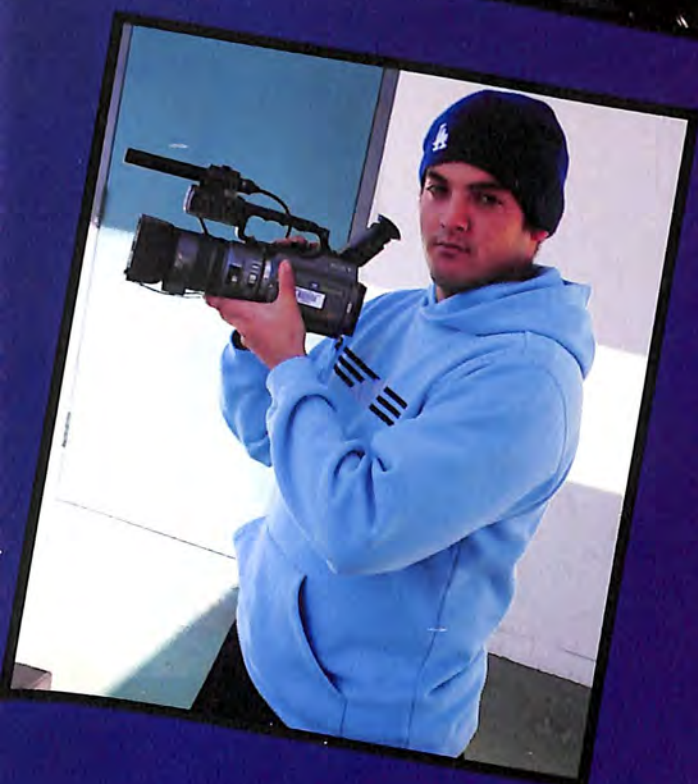
Each class is filled with amazingly creative and talented students. This year, they put on the third annual "Twilight Zone" Festival, a night that showcases films, where students have to write an extensive script and storyboard for the film and then produce it. Also, this year Mr. Reale started a new project, a 48 hour film festival. Students are given 48 hours to write, tape, and edit an original short film. One of the students, Danielle Ordunio-Palomares said, "It was really fun, but really tough because it was a short period of time so you had to be efficient. Overall, it was stressful but gave me an adrenaline rush."

If you flip on your TV to the local city channel you might see some of the student's work. This year the Tech class, under the guidance of producer Kelsey Kilbury, brought Monrovia High School's news program back to cable TV and made it better than before. Also, Effy Gomez and a team of students produced many episodes of "Coaches Corner" which interviews coaches and star players from MHS. Mr. Reale hopes that sometime soon they will be able to broadcast these programs in the classroom.

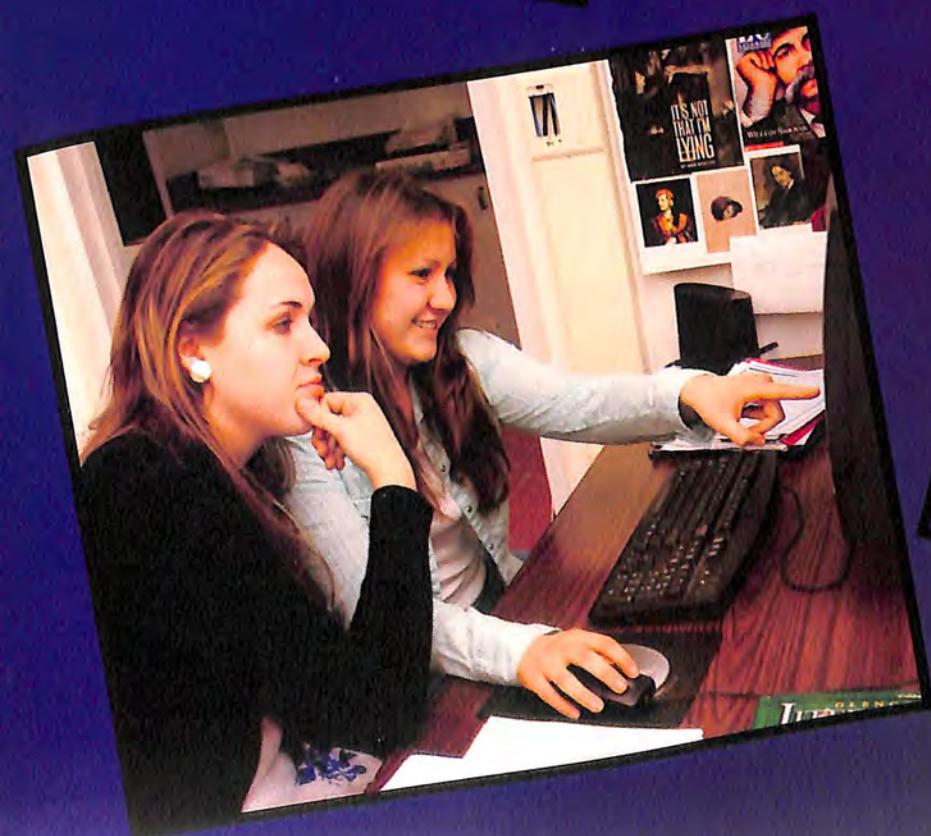

A Difference Abroad

Our World, these past years, has been full of destruction. From the many different natural disasters to the war against terrorism, people's lives and homes have been shattered. However, many people are rising to the occasion and stepping up to help. Monrovia High School can take pride in the fact that it had many extraordinary students stepping up to the occasion.

In January of 2006, the students and staff members at Monrovia were heart broken to find out that Raul Mercado, who had graduated in 2004, had died in Iraq. Raul was a hard working student and touched many people's hearts. After graduating, he joined the Marines so that he could further his education in a military academy. However, on January 7, 2006, Raul gave his life for his country while bravely fighting the war against terrorism.

Natural disasters have been causing great destruction in many parts of the world. In July 2005, Stephanie Horak went with a group of students, sponsored by Relief International, to Sri Lanka to help the victims of a tsunami. The group was there for a three week period and did many different projects to help the citizens. They organized and ran a "fun day" for orphan children of the tsunami, white-washed a Buddhist temple, hand mixed cement to lay a concrete foundation for an outside kitchen, rebuilt a medicine garden, and resupplied a preschool who lost seventy percent of their students to the tsunami.

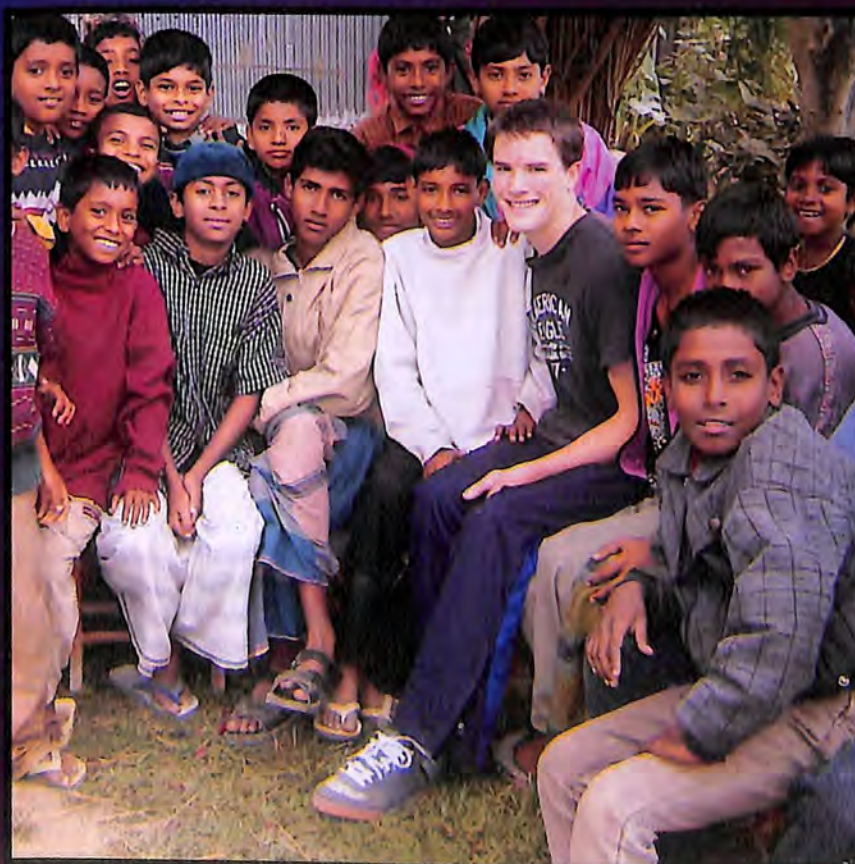
In December, Stephanie got another chance to travel to another country to help the citizens there. She served as a Youth Chaperone on a trip to Bangladesh. Ryan Theimer also participated on this trip to help the citizens of Bangladesh. Both students feel that their lives have been changed after these experiences and that they grew and learned a lot while volunteering in these countries.

The rest of Monrovia High has also been stepping it up. Many students and staff members have participated in the blood drives put on through the school year. Our service clubs have volunteered in the community and fundraised to help others. Monrovia High student and staff members are really making a difference and will continue to be a piece of the action when it comes to helping.
