To My Fellow Employees:

At this beginning of a new year it is natural for us to wish and hope that it will be a happy one. But facing realities we realize that we are not in a "living as usual" situation, and that we must accept our responsibilities to do our part in keeping our country strong and free.

For ourselves and our families we must tighten our belts, give up some things, and make other sacrifices. Many of our family ties will be broken by calls to military service or defense work.

For our railroad, in addition to our regular patrons, we must render dependable and safe transportation of our military forces and their equipment and supplies. We must serve efficiently the factories producing for defense and protection of our homeland. We must take care of our locomotives, cars, tools, and other property, knowing that materials are in short supply.

For our governments, we must support their defense efforts. We should especially urge reduction in public expenditures for purposes other than military. We cannot produce guns, tanks, ships, planes and munitions and at the same time have new bridges, new dams, new roads, and new social benefits that just now we don't absolutely need.

We must recognize the desirability of paying cash for our mounting expenses out of current earnings, and this applies to both personal and governmental spending. The more we borrow now the more we mortgage our future and our children's future. Aside from the burden of a great debt, borrowed money competes for scarce materials and thus increases prices and reduces the buying value of our earned money. In arming and supporting our military forces we must not let ourselves be bled to death by debt and inflation.

Since we must place duty and austerity ahead of happiness and prosperity, it is my sincere wish that during the new year we meet our responsibilities with courage and determination; thus we will contribute toward peace and happiness in future years.




Dear Dr:
